


18" RING LIGHT KIT

QUICK START GUIDE

Components

- (1) 18" Ring Light
- (1) Power Supply
- (2) NP-750 Batteries
- (1) Battery Charger
- (1) Mobile Device Mount
- (1) Gooseneck Arm with 1/4"-20 Thread
- (1) Swivel Mount with 1/4"-20 Thread
- (1) 5.75' Light Stand
- (1) Carry Case



Warning

- · Only use with the included AC power supply and power cord.
- Only use with NP-F Series batteries of the same capacity (Voltage Range: 7.4V-12V).
- Both batteries should have the same state of charge when mounted. Avoid using a fully-charged battery and a partially depleted battery at the same time.
- Always remove batteries during storage and/or transport to avoid accidental operation which may lead to overheating if in the travel case.
- · Keep away from fire and water.
- · Do not submerge in water.
- · Do not force electrical connections.
- Do not overtighten the mounting and/or tilting knob.
- · Do not overtighten accessories to the mounting thread or cold shoes.
- · Do not attempt to open or modify Ring Light.

Setup

Attaching to a Light Stand

Turn the lower tension knob counterclockwise to allow mounting to the light stand. Once mounted, turn the knob clockwise to secure the connection.

Do not overtighten tension knob.

Tilting the Ring Light

Once mounted and secured to the light stand, use the higher tension knob to adjust the tilt.

Do not overtighten tension knob.

- 1. Turn the knob counterclockwise.
- Adjust the Ring Light to the desired position by tilting the unit back and forth.
- 3. Turn the knob clockwise to lock the Ring Light into position.

Basic Operation

AC Ring Light Operation

- Ensure the Ring Light is OFF by moving the power selector to the middle position [O].
- 2. Connect the included AC power supply and power cord.
- Insert the AC power supply's barrel plug into the AC receptacle on the back of the Ring Light.
- 4. Insert the power cord into a standard wall outlet.
- Press the double-line (||) side of the power selector when using the AC power supply to power ON.

DC Ring Light Operation

The Ring Light will only operate on DC power when TWO charged batteries are connected to the unit.

- Ensure the Ring Light is OFF by moving the power selector to the middle position [O].
- Align the battery's female connection points with the Ring Light's barrel-shaped connection points.
- With the battery flat against the Ring Light, gently slide the battery outwards until the connection is secure. Repeat this process to install the 2nd battery.
- Press the single-line (I) side of the power selector when using batteries to power ON.

Available Modes

Pressing the dimming knob down continuously will cycle the Ring Light through three different modes: Light Output, Color Temperature, and Battery Status.

Light Output

By default, the Ring Light will start in the Light Output Mode and the LED indicator square next to the "BRT" will illuminate. While in Light Output Mode, turn the dimming knob to adjust the light output level from low (P-00) to high (P-100).

Color Temperature

Press the dimming knob down to select Color Temperature Mode. The LED indicator square next to the "CCT" will illuminate and the screen will display the current Kelvin Color Temperature (3200K-5600K, ±300K tolerance). Turn the dimming knob to adjust the color temperature in ± 100K steps.

Battery Status

Press the dimming knob again to select Battery Status Mode. The LED indicator square next to the "BATT" will illuminate and the screen will display the status of the batteries.

"FULL" will be displayed when batteries are fully charged. A range between E-00 (low) to E-10 (high) will be displayed for all other charge levels. When batteries are depleted (E-00), the unit will automatically turn off after a short period of time.

Battery charge time up to 6 hours.

When using the AC power supply, the Battery Status screen will display "FULL".

Warranty
