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

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Materials

⅓ yard	Check - Gray (A)	456-90*
3/8 yard	Stripe - Gray (B)	455-90
½ yard	Trees - Multi (C)	452-9
1/4 yard	Chipmunks and Birds - Multi (D)	454-3
⅓ yard	Dots - Light Beige (E)	444-30
5/8 yard	Small Vine and Buds - Cream (F)	442-6
3 yards	Tossed Bunnies - Gray (Backing)	448-90

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Check - Gray (A), cut:

- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Stripe - Gray (B), cut:

• (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips.

From the Trees - Multi (C), cut:

• (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 6 ½" squares.

From the Chipmunks and Birds - Multi (D), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Dots - Light Beige (E), cut:

- (2) 2" x 30 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 33 ½" WOF strips.

From the Small Vine and Buds - Cream (F), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x 33 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 4 ½" x 41 ½" WOF strips.

From the Tossed Bunnies - Gray (Backing), cut:


• (2) 49" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 49" x 49" back.

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
Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- 1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric A strip to each side of (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Strip Set 1.
- 2. Cut the Strip Set 1's into (26) 2 ½" x 6 ½" Unit 1 strips (Fig. 2).




- 3. Sew (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric A strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 2 (Fig. 3).
- 4. Cut the Strip Set 2 into (13) 2 ½" x 6 ½" Unit 2 strips (Fig. 4).




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5. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 2 strip lengthwise to make (1) 6 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (13) Block One squares total.



- 6. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) 6 ½" Fabric C squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 6). Repeat to make Row Five.
- 7. Sew together (1) 6 ½" Fabric C square, (1) Unit 1 square, (1) 6 ½" Fabric D square, (1) Unit 1 square and (1) 6 ½" Fabric C square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two (Fig. 6). Repeat to make Row Four.
- 8. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) 6 ½" Fabric D squares, alternating them from left to right, to make Row Three (Fig. 6).
- 9. Sew together the (5) Rows from Steps 6-8, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 30 ½" x 30 ½" Center Block (Fig. 6).




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Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 10. Sew (1) 2" x 30 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 33 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 11. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 33 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 41 ½" Fabric F stir to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 12. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 13. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric A strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and
- 14. Bind as desired.



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
