



*Substitute 1/3 yard cuts for the Fat Quarters. Cut (2) 5" strips and subcut into (12) 5" x 5" squares.

Cutting

Fabrics 1-8 Fat Quarters
From each cut

A: (12) 5" x 5" squares You will use one of each FQ per block. See diagram below.

Fabric 9

Cut (7) 5" x WOF strips. Subcut into:

A: (12) 5" x 5" squares B: (96) 2" x 5" rectangles

Cut (20) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut into:

C: (384) 2" x 2" squares

Cut (3) 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut into D: (48) 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

Note: Each block uses these F9 pieces

(1) F9-A square

(32) F9-C squares (8) F9-B rectangles

(4) F9-D rectangles

(1)17 Directarigi

Binding Cut (7) strips 2-1/4" x WOF

Paper Flurries Quilt Instructions

Please read all instructions before you begin. Seam allowance is 1/4. Fabric is abbreviated as 'F' - for example, F1 refers to Fabric 1. Press in the direction of arrows.

Use the □ check boxes to mark each step as you complete it.

Snowball Blocks

Gather the F1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, & 8A squares. Reserve the F9-A squares. Gather the F9-C squares.

- □ 1. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of (4) F9-C squares.
- ☐ 2. Place a C square, RST, on the top corner of a F1-A square. Sew on the marked line.
- □ 3. Repeat on the remaining 3 corners.
- □ 4. Press the corners away from the center to set the seams, then fold the corners back and trim the outer corners off 1/4" away from the stitching.

Make 12 sets of each snowball.

Center Snowball Units


Gather the F9 -B rectangles and the F1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8 snowball blocks.

- □ 1. Lay an F9-B rectangle, RST, over one side of an F1 snowball block. Sew together. Press towards center.
- 2. Repeat to make 12 center snowball units with each of the snowball blocks...

Make 12 of each 5" x 6-1/2"



Corner Snowball Units

Gather the F9 -D rectangles and the F1, 3, 5, & 7 center snowball units.

☐ 1. Lay an F9-D rectangle, RST, over the left side of an F1 center snowball unit. Sew together. Press towards center.

■ 2. Repeat to make 12 corner snowball units each with the F3, F5, & F7 units.





Make 12 of each 6-1/2" x 6-1/2"







Sew the Snowballs into Blocks

Gather the F9-A squares. All 12 blocks are the same layout.

☐ 1. Lay the snowball units out in rows as illustrated. Rotate the units as needed.

Row 1: F1 Corner | F2 Center | F3 Corner

Row 2: F8 Center | F9-A | F4 Center

Row 3: F7 Corner | F6 Center | F5 Corner

☐ 2. Sew row to row. Press in one direction. Make 12.









Quilt Top, Borders, and Finishing


- □ 1. Lay out the blocks in groups of three as illustrated below. The blocks rotate clockwise. Sew the blocks together into rows. Press to nest.
- 2. Sew row to row. Press in one direction.



- □ 3. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste layers to secure. Quilt as desired. Trim the excess backing and batting.
- □ 4. Sew the binding strips together into one continuous strip. Press in half length-wise. Sew the binding to the quilt top with a 1/4" seam allowance. Turn the binding to the back side of the quilt and stitch down by hand with matching thread.


Paper Flurries Quilt Planning Diagram

Optional paper piecing method for sewing the snowball units. Copy 96 times at 100%.



Print template at 100%. Check the 1" test square

The inside (without the seam allowance) measures 4-1/2" x 4-1/2". The outside (with the seam allowance) measures 5" x 5".
