Assembling the Blocks:



"Halloweenie" Panel Squares Blocks:

1. Set aside the fussy cut squares of Fabric 1. (Four of the panel squares will be used for the border.)



Rail Fence Blocks:

2. Using ¼″ seam allowance throughout, with Right Sides Together (RST), sew one strip of Fabric 2, one strip of Fabric 3, and one strip of Fabric 4, to create a strip set. Make a total of 4 strip sets. Press seams away from center. **Sub-cut 24 squares measuring 6**½″.







Nine Patch Blocks:

3. Column 1: Sew one strip set using Fabric 5, 6 and 7 in this order. Press seams TOWARD center. Then, sub-cut strip sets into $(24) \, 2\frac{1}{2}$ " segments.





4. Column 2: Sew one strip set using Fabric 6, 7 and 8 in this order. Press seams AWAY from center. Then, sub-cut strip sets into (16) 2½" segments.





5. Column 3: Sew one strip set using Fabric 7, 8, and 5 in this order. Press seams TOWARD center. Then, sub-cut strip sets into $(16) 2\frac{1}{2}$ segments.






6. Make Nine Patch Blocks by sewing columns together as shown, matching intersections. Press seams toward center. Make 16 Nine Patch Blocks.



Arrange the Quilt Top:

7. Gather and arrange blocks as shown. Sew the blocks together creating rows, pressing in direction of arrows. Sew rows together and press seams open.



Borders:

8. Layout border fabric around the perimeter of the quilt top. Using the remaining fussy cut panel blocks, sew desired blocks to the corners of the top and bottom borders. Sew side borders, then top and bottom borders to quilt top.

Finish:

9. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired and bind using your favorite technique.

	Fabric 3 8617-G ¹ ⁄ ₃ yd	From Fabric 3, cut: 4 — 2½" x WOF strips	Fabric 8 8632-J 1/4 yd	From Fabric 8, cut: 2 — 2½" x WOF strips
	Fabric 4 8625-JO ⅓ yd	From Fabric 4, cut: 4 — 2½″ x WOF strips	Fabric 9 8631-Z 1½ yds	Layout and locate 4 identical border fabric repeats and measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " wide. Fussy cut first strip $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ ". Use this strip as a guide to cut 3 more fabric repeat borders, all measuring $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ ".
