2023 SRC Grant Program Guidelines

The 2023 SRC Grant Program is designed to empower the Loftus PS SRC to seek funding for initiatives and/or items that will benefit their school community.

Guidelines –

1. The SRC will develop a grant application using the application form. Grant applications should be completed in full and accompanied by quotes for items (where relevant).
2. Multiple applications are allowed, but a maximum **total** of \$1,000 will be approved.
3. Applications are to be submitted to the P&C via loftuspnc@gmail.com by Monday 7th August 2023.
4. Grant applications for 2023 will be reviewed by the P&C Executive, with suitable applications to be considered at the Term 3 Week 7 P&C General Meeting.
5. The P&C will provide feedback to the SRC about any unsuccessful grant applications.

Criteria –

Grant applications that are more likely to be successful will:

- ✓ Benefit students from multiple year groups
 - ✓ Clearly show how the initiative/item will benefit the school community
 - ✓ Have a budget that demonstrates good “value for money”
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
