ONLY 12% OF CHILDREN'S BOOKS ARE ABOUT BLACK OR AFRICAN CHARACTERS.

Only 12% of children's books are about Black or African characters. Furthermore, 2021 saw a 23% decrease in children's bestsellers with Black and African main characters (CCBC, 2022).

At Kunda Kids, we strongly believe that <u>every child</u> should have exposure to diverse and inclusive stories that make them feel represented and teach them about other people and places.




OUR STORY

Oladele is a former consultant and Cambridge MBA Alumni. Louisa is a former journalist, TEDx organiser and innovation specialist at Unilever.





KUNDA KIDS, INSPIRING THE NEXT GENERATION ABOUT AFRICA

London, United Kingdom [February 2023]

Kunda Kids is an award-winning children's publishing, media and EdTech company. Founded in 2020, Kunda Kids is committed to inspiring the next generation with diverse characters. Each story promotes all-important soft skills such as self-confidence, teamwork and kindness - essential for children's development.

Kunda Kids transcends the norm by infusing African culture into modern storylines with inspiring and adventurous characters. The founders, a married couple, and parents, Oladele and Louisa Olafuyi, developed the business to showcase various elements of African culture in creative and simple formats for children.

Kunda Kids boasts an impressive 20k+ books sold in just two years, available in over 130 countries and 300+ schools and libraries worldwide. The award-winning collection 'Africa's Little Kings & Queens' put the independent publisher on the map as a positive disruption to the publishing industry, notorious for its poor reputation in achieving diversity and inclusion in books, authors, and artists.

Currently, only 12% of published children's books worldwide feature a black and African main character (2021) and whilst general children's book sales went up during and post-pandemic, children's bestsellers with Black and African main characters decreased by 23%. This sparked a desire for Oladele and Louisa to inspire a new generation with a fuller understanding of Africa.

In a world increasingly becoming more globalised and diverse, parents and educators are looking for creative ways to help their kids embrace their culture.

In response, Kunda Kids released the Kunda Kids App in May 2021, which features children's literature and African language learning animations. With more than one billion native speakers in Africa, the app aims to promote African languages as a part of everyday life and to help children learn about Africa's rich heritage and diverse languages.

"Gen-Alpha are digital natives, and so the development of the Kunda Kids app made perfect sense to reach children through a familiar and fun format" - Oladele Olafuyi, Co-founder, Kunda Kids.

In January 2023, Kunda Kids released its 12th print and first non-fiction title; A is for Africa, a joyful ABC book that challenges the relatively unchanged introduction to the alphabet where A is almost always for apple. A is for Africa takes readers on a beautifully illustrated and informative journey across Africa's history and culture.

2023 is set to be an exciting year for Kunda Kids, starting with a series of book tours across Nigeria during January, book readings to celebrate Black History Month (U.S) in February and a packed schedule of events and family experiences to celebrate World Book Day throughout March.
