



Done in a sport-weight yarn, this quick & easy pattern makes a fantastic washcloth or handcloth. Knit it up in a bulky yarn and its the idea hotpad!

half-linen washcloth & potholder

designed by rene conn

finished measurements

8 ¾ (9.5)" square.

yarn

Catania Denim (100% Cotton; 137 yds/50g)

1 ball, shown in color 102 - Natural

OR

Katia Cotton Cord (100% Cotton; 55yds/100g)

1 ball, shown in color 50 - White & 62 - Jeans

gauge

23 sts x 32 rows (11 sts x 18 rows) = 4" x 4"

needles

US 5 (mm) / US 11 (mm) needles

Adjust size if necessary to obtain gauge.

hooks

H-8 (5mm) / L-11(8mm) hook

notions

tapestry needle

directions

CO 48 (24) sts

Work in half-linen stitch as follows:

Row 1 (WS): Purl.

Row 2 (RS): K1, *k1, slip next stitch with yarn in front, repeat from * to last stitch, k1.

Row 3: Purl.

Row 4: K1, *slip next stitch with yarn in front, k1, repeat from * across.

Repeat rows 1 - 4 until cloth is square.

crochet border

For washcloth:

Crochet one round of single crochet around the border of cloth.

Both washcloth & potholder:

Work a round of extended reverse single crochet around the border of cloth (*chain 2, reverse single crochet, repeat from * around).



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
