

# be my honeybee

#### finished dimensions

11" wide x 84" long, after blocking

#### yarn

Anzula Breeze (65% Silk, 35% Linen; 750 yds / 114 g) ½ ball shown in Penny
Alchemy Haiku (60%, 40% Silk; 325 yds / 25 g)
1 skein shown in Paper Crane

#### needles

US 11 (7 mm) needles or size needed to obtain gauge

#### gauge

15 sts x 16 rows = 4" x 4" in pattern, after blocking

#### notions

tapestry needle, blocking wires & pins (optional)

## directions

CO 43sts

Row 1: Sl1, \*yo, k2tog, rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 2: Sl1, purl to end, k1.

Row 3: Sl1, k1, \*yo, k2tog, rep from \* to last st, k1.

Row 4: Sl1, purl to end, k1.

Repeat these 4 rows until 3 yards remain.

### finishing

Bind off all sts. Weave in ends and block to measurements.
