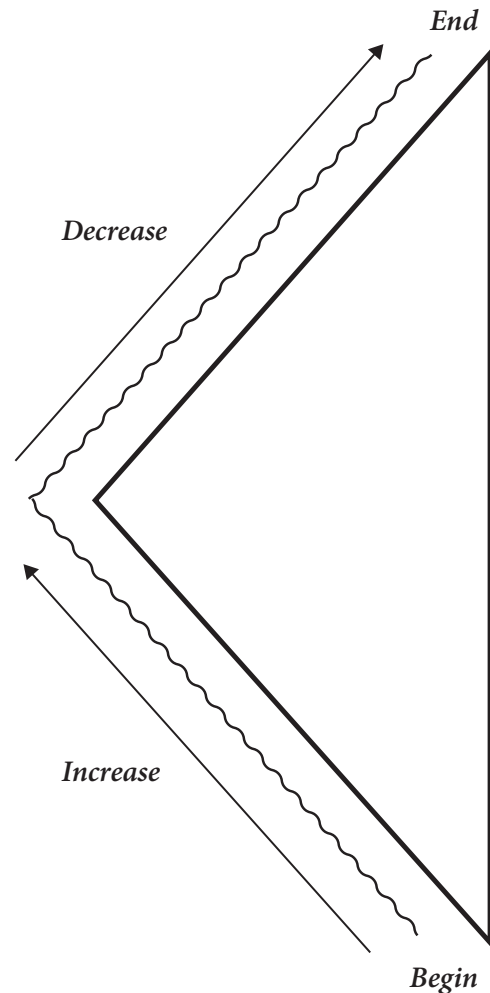




Ida Red

Hill Country Weavers



Yarn:

1 skein Handmaiden Maiden Hair
(67% Silk, 23% Kid Mohair, 10% Nylon; 100g / 300m)

Needles:

US size 8 needles

Notions:

1 stitch marker

Directions:

Cast on 6 stitches.

First half of scarf—increase rows:

Row 1 (WS): Purl
 Row 2: K1, increase in next stitch by knitting into front and back, place marker, K4
 Row 3: P4, slip marker, P to end of row
 Row 4: K to first stitch before marker, increase, slip marker, K4
 Repeat Rows 3 & 4 until a little less than half the yarn is used, ending with Row 3, ready to start a RS.

Second half—decrease rows:

Row 5 (RS): K to 2 stitches before marker, K2tog, slip marker, K4
 Row 6: P4, slip marker, P to end of row
 Repeat Rows 5 & 6 until 7 stitches remain.

Finish:

Row 7 (RS): K1, K2tog, K4
 Row 8: Purl
 Row 9: K2tog, remove marker leaving 4 stitches unworked on left hand needle. Cut yarn leaving approximately 6" and pull through the stitch just worked. Unravel the unworked 4 stitches all along scarf to form the fringe. Knot fringe close to base if desired.
