

# magic plaid

## finished dimensions

12" wide x 66" long, excluding fringe and after finishing.

*14.25" wide x 92" long, on loom.*

## yarn

Berroco Medina

(37% Cotton, 36% Acrylic, 27% Viscose;

295 yds / 100 g)

1 ball color A, *shown in color 4767 (warp)*

1 ball color B, *shown in color 4791 (weft)*

## sett

8 epi x 8 ppi

## equipment

15" or wider rigid heddle loom

8 dent heddle

stick shuttle

## notions

waste yarn

# directions

## Warping

Set your warping peg approximately 92" from the back of your loom and wind a direct warp 14.25" wide or using the entirety of one ball of Berroco Medina in color A.

The completed warp will be approximately 114 ends / 57 loops wide.\*

*\*it is not important for this to be exact for this project.*

## Weaving

Weave 1- 2" of waste yarn before continuing in plain weave with Berroco Medina in color B.

**\*\***Leaving a tail 2-3 times the width of your weaving, work 6 picks of plain weave, then work your hemstitch on the loom over 3 ends and in 2 picks across the starting edge before proceeding.

Continue weaving until all of your weft yarn is used, or until your warp is completely woven, leaving a tail of weft yarn 2-3 times the width of your weaving.

Finish by working a hemstitch along the top of the weaving edge before removing the work from the loom.

## Finishing

Handwash the finished weaving, blot with a towel to damp and dry in the dryer on low. Press with an iron trim fringes even.
