
Pretty in Pink by suzanne middlebrooks





finished dimensions

16.5" wide x 74" long, excluding fringe and after finishing.

approximately 18.3" wide x 100" long, on loom.

yarn

naturally HCW Man-Shack Forever (100% Highland Wool, 437 yds / 100 g) 2 skeins

Accent Color: Approximately 50 yds of Fingering or Sport weight yarn in a high contrast color.

equipment

20" or wider rigid heddle loom 10 dent heddle two stick shuttles

notions

waste yarn, tapestry needle.



directions

Warping

Set your warping peg approximately 100" from the back of your loom and direct warp as follows:

Using Main Yarn, warp 22 ends. Using Accent Yarn, warp 1 end.

Repeat these 23 ends 7 more times.

Using Main Yarn, warp 22 ends.

The completed warp will be 183 ends wide.

Weaving

Wind 2 shuttles, one with Main Yarn & one with Accent Yarn.

Weave 1- 2" of waste yarn before continuing in plain weave as follows:

Work 22 picks of Main Yarn. Work 1 pick of Accent Yarn.

Note: Weave in the ends on the selvages as you work for the Accent yarn. You can carry the marled yarn up the sides as you weave - no need to break the main yarn between stripes.

Repeat this sequence throughout the scarf, taking care to maintain a consistent beat - you want to have equal EPI (Ends per Inch) & PPI (Picks per Inch) for best effect. Aim for 10 PPI as you weave.

End by weaving 1-2" of waste yarn before cutting off the loom.

Finishing

On both ends of the work, use a tapestry needle to weave the accent color back into the work to secure if you do not want these to be a part of the fringe.

Wash and steam press finished scarf with an iron and twist the fringes in bundles of 3 x 3.
