

santorini scarf

Santorini is a great choice for a first or second weaving project. This clever yarn changes both color and texture as you weave to create a plaid-like look without the extra work!

finished dimensions

6" wide x 52" long, not including fringe, after finishing.

7.5" wide in heddle x 72" long warp.

yarn

Classic Elite Santorini (58% Viscose, 42% Cotton, 125 yds / 50g)

2 balls

equipment

rigid heddle loom

8 dent heddle

sett

8 epi x 8 ppi

notions

waste yarn



directions

Warp your loom using the first ball of Santorini. If you set your peg 72" away from the back of the loom and warp 7.5" wide you should use all of one ball.

Weave 1-2" of waste yarn, switch to working yarn, and weave in plain weave until you reach the end of the warp or the end of the second ball of Santorini. Be careful not to beat too tightly or your fabric will be stiff and you may run out of yarn. You should be looking for a balanced fabric - about 8 picks over 1".

Weave a bit more waste yarn at the end of the scarf and cut from the loom.

finishing

Finish your scarf with overhand knots or the fringe treatment of your choice. Trim fringe even. Hand wash and press with a low iron.
