

directions

Choose one skein to be Color A and one skein to be Color B. You will alternate between Colors A & B every 2 rows throughout the shawl.

Note: To avoid weaving in lots of ends - do not break yarn between color changes.

With Color A cast on 80 stitches Knit 2 rows. Switch to Color B and knit 2 rows.

Continuing to alternate between Colors A & B every 2 rows, begin working Wave Pattern as follows:

Row 1: K4, [k2tog three times, (yo, k1) six times, k2tog three times] repeat 4 times, k4 Row 2: Knit Row 3: Knit Row 4: K4, purl until 4 stitches remain, k4

Winding Fields

finished dimensions

14" wide x 95" long

yarn

Noro Kureyon Sock (70% Wool, 30% Nylon; 420 m / 100 g) 1 skein each in 2 different colors OR Noro Taiyo Sock (50% Cotton, 17% Wool, 17% Polyamide, 16% Silk; 420 m / 100 g) 1 skein each in 2 different colors

needles US 8 (5mm) needles

gauge 22 sts x 18 rows = 4" x 4" in wave pattern.

notions tapestry needle, blocking wires & pins (optional)



Repeat rows 1-4 until desired length is reached.

Repeat row 1 once more. Knit 3 rows. Bind off all stitches.

finishing

Weave in ends and block to measurements.
