

austin poncho

finished dimensions

24" wide x 50" long, before seaming.

yarn

Feza Alp Natural (40% Cotton, 40% Viscose, 10% Silk, 10% Linen; 231 yds / 100 g)

3 skeins, shown in Black

needles

US 9 (5.5mm) needles

adjust needle size as nessecary to obtain gauge.

gauge

15 sts x 20 rows = 4" x 4" in stockinette.

notions

tapestry needle, blocking wires & pins (optional)

Note:

Alp Natural is a hand-tied yarn, composed of many different fibers and textures of yarn. You have a few options for your finishing a project knit in this yarn. If you like the organic look with the ties hanging out you may choose to leave the ends where they land. For those of you who don't like the look of the hanging ends you may want to untie the ends and weave them in as you knit or choose to weave them in after you finish your garment.



directions

Cast on 90 stitches using the long-tailed cast on or a cable cast on.

Knit 3 rows.

Begin working in stockinette

(Knit one row, Purl one row)

Continue until you have 14 yards remaining.

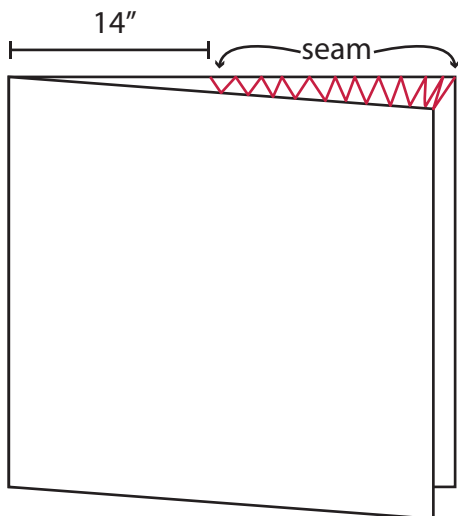
Knit 3 rows.

Bind off all sts.

finishing

Fold the fabric rectangle in half and seam with a mattress stitch, leaving a gap in the middle for the neckline as shown.

Weave in ends and block to measurements.



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
