# finished dimensions

10" wide x 62" long, excluding fringe and after finishing. 11.4" wide x 100" long, on loom.

#### yarn

Gedifra Creativo (67% Virgin Wool, 18% Viscose, 15% Polyamide; 110 yds / 50 g) 2 balls, *shown in color 2604* 

Brooklyn Tweed Peerie (100% Nevada & Utah Grown Merino Wool, 210 yds / 50g)

2 hanks, shown in color Gatsby

sett 10 epi x 9 ppi

## equipment

12" or wider rigid heddle loom 10 dent heddle stick shuttle

notions waste yarn



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# directions

### Warping

Set your warping peg approximately 100" from the back of your loom and direct warp using Brooklyn Tweed Peerie

The completed warp will be approximately 114 ends / 57 loops wide.

Note: it's not important that this is exact for this scarf, just be sure your total warp ends is divisible by 4.

### Weaving

Weave 1- 2" of waste yarn before continueing in plain weave.

Continue in plain weave using the Gedifra Creativo yarn\* until you have used all of 2 balls, or until your warp is completely woven.

End by weaving 1-2" of waste yarn before cutting off the loom.

\*when winding the Gedifra Creativo onto your stick shuttles, you can wind all of one ball onto a single shuttle, or wind half onto one shuttle and then half onto a second shuttle.

If you wind onto 2 shuttles, begin weaving with the second wound shuttle first. This will preserve the color patterns in the yarn as you weave.

## Finishing

Tie off the warp in knot bundles of 4 ends each as you remove your waste yarn.

Handwash the finished weaving, blot with a towel to damp and dry in the dryer on low. Press with an iron trim fringes even.
