

Designed for purpose and durability, the Algonquin was built as a workhorse—shaped to carry both paddlers and gear across lakes of all sizes, in all weather conditions. Its deep hull, clean lines, and increasing rocker allow the 16-footer to glide quickly and handle effortlessly, whether paddled empty or loaded with gear.

Over 2,000 gleaming brass tacks shine through the hull's mirror-polished, low-maintenance epoxy skin, completing the Algonquin's timeless appeal.
