

Important Information - Please Read Me First!

Your order contains dormant, bare root hibiscus. Dormancy is the natural resting stage for plants and generally occurs between fall and spring. It is very beneficial for plants to remain dormant during the shipping and planting process because there are no new tender roots and shoots that could be damaged. While the dormant plants may appear somewhat bare and lifeless, rest assured they will begin setting new roots and growing soon after being planted.

As the weather warms and the days grow longer, your hibiscus plants will wake up naturally from their dormant state. Keep in mind that plants do not always break dormancy at the same time. Even plants within the same species often leaf out at different times over a period of several weeks. Perennial hibiscus is one of the last plants in the garden to break dormancy in spring, and initially it may grow slowly if the weather is still cool in your area. This is no cause for concern. Please plant your bare root hibiscus when you receive them and follow the planting and care instructions provided in your planting guide. Your patience will be greatly rewarded, and as always, Cottage Farms plants are fully guaranteed!

If planting must be delayed due to weather or unforeseen circumstances, leave your bare root hibiscus in the poly bags they came in, and place them in a cool, dark location. A refrigerator is ideal, but an unheated garage or basement will also work. Be sure to keep the roots moist (but not soaking wet) by misting them with a spray bottle as needed.
