Deep crimson. Fresh dark plum, blackberry, roasted hazelnut, hint black liquorice aromas. Well concentrated dark chocolate, blackberry, satsuma plum flavours, fine slinky textures and underlying savoury notes. Finishes firm and tight with some black olive notes.

Tasting notes:

Crimson red in colour, with the aromas of ripe blackberry, black cherry, and plum fruits. Subtle undertones of baking spices, licorice, and cocoa powder on the palate wine. Hints of choc-mint and smoked meats arise, intensifying the flavour that gracefully has you wanting more.

Jason's Notes:

The first parcel of shiraz for The Grower was picked on 1^{st} March from the Barossa Valley, with the last parcel from Eden Valley on the $5^{th of}$ April.

The fruit comes from ten different Sub regions, from thirteen different growers, predominately Gomersal (Sieber and Lienert), Bethany (Schwarz), Stonewell (McDonald and Hudson) and Marananga (Mirus).

20% of the wine for the blend was matured in small tank, with the remainder of the wine matured in French oak Vat, Puncheon and Hogs heads.

The final wine was blended in March 2023, and bottled 29th of May 2023.





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
