AN INTERVIEW WITH DOKIMONBREAKS

What's your favourite TCG?


Have you completed any major goals recently?

Sylveon is my favourite Pokémon, so I'd love to have one of each Sylveon card that's been printed so far! I'm still missing a few of the more expensive ones, but I do think this will be realistic for me at some stage.





What do you dislike about collecting?

I don't know that I'd say there's anything I really dislike. Sometimes I wish it was a bit less expensive, but in the end it's worth it to me for the appreciation of my collection and recognition for the amount of effort that's gone into all the incredible artworks.

What do you love about collecting?

I love the community, it's been so cool to meet people from all over the world and share this awesome hobby with them! I also really enjoy art in general, so I always get excited to see the artwork for new sets! One of my favourite ways to engage with the hobby is through art, so I love painting extended artworks in appreciation of the beautiful common cards.

Is there anyone who inspires you within the hobby?

sezzadactyl was the main reason I decided to have a crack at painting card alters in the first place – I love her artworks and style, so would definitely have to say she's inspired me a lot! I also love okjluv – he's an awesome Australian streamer and youtuber who approaches his content with a really well balanced sense of humor as well as maturity. The female trainers also totally inspire me to be the best version of myself I can and keep growing and learning. I love cosplaying my favourites and sharing the love on Instagram!



Do you collect TCG's, play TCG's or both?

I am mostly a collector at the moment; Pokémon has been my main squeeze for a while but I haven't played a game for a while. I enjoy playing board games, tabletop RPG and Magic the Gathering but am not super into collecting them!

What's your favourite purchase, trade or sale you've completed?



Purists will probably hate this, but aside from having a few sets in binders I love making pages that are just full of my favourites – I have some dedicated to Sylveon, Mew, Pikachu, Dedenne, the Dragonite family etc. and they always make me smile!

I collect both Japanese and English. In terms of printing quality, I really prefer the Japanese cards; however I can't read it (yet) so enjoy having English for that reason!






Do you keep sealed products?
















REVIEW: SHOW-DEX PRO PREMIUM TOPLOADER BINDER 9-POCKET

As soon as I saw the announcement of these binders from Show-Dex I had to get my preorder in. I'd been looking for a toploader binder for a while but hadn't seen one I liked. Knowing the quality of the 9-pocket premium binder from Show-Dex it made sense to stick with a brand I trusted.

Once again, the packaging for this product is impressive. Well presented, branded and also offers a good level of protection to the binder during shipping.

The binder itself is quite big, it's not something you can put in a regular-size backpack but storing the binder on a shelf or other storage space shouldn't be an issue.

I prefer to also store my toploaders in a team bag to stop dust from getting in the top. This didn't affect the cards being added to the binder and offers an additional level of protection alongside the zip on the binder.

The toploaders slide into the pages very easy and once you also have a card stored on the next page directly behind the pocket it helps tighten everything up and make them even more secure.

With a capacity of 216 and a very reasonable price of £27.99, this is a great way to store a large number of cards while also offering a lot of security.


For me, this is another 5-star product which I would happily recommend to others.
