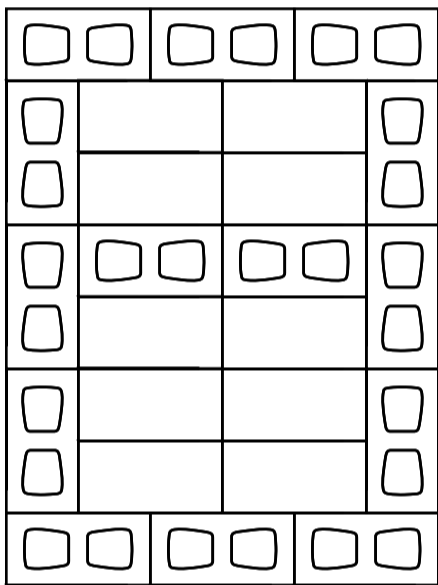


DIY | DESKTOP PENCIL HOLDER AND PLANTER

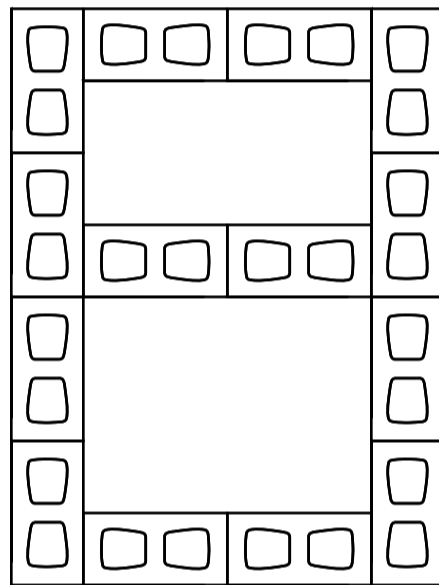
- SUPPLIES NEEDED:**
- Mini Materials Cinder Blocks (1:12 scale) - 100 pack
(you will have two leftover)
 - Mini Materials Mortar - 4 to 6 oz
(depending on how much you want to use)
 - Miniature Succulent
 - Soil
 - Pens and Pencils



FIRST LAYER

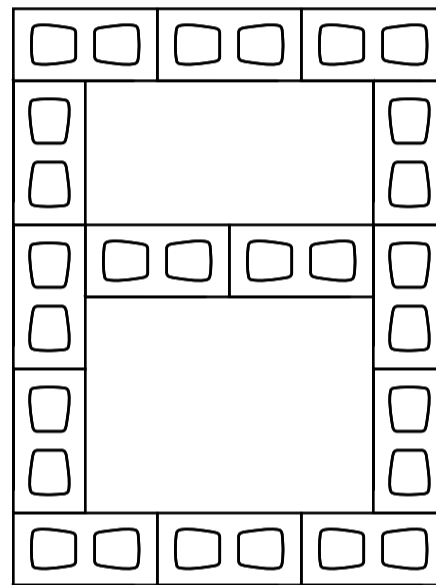
of bricks: 24

This layer will have 10 interior bricks that will have the solid side exposed to create a base.



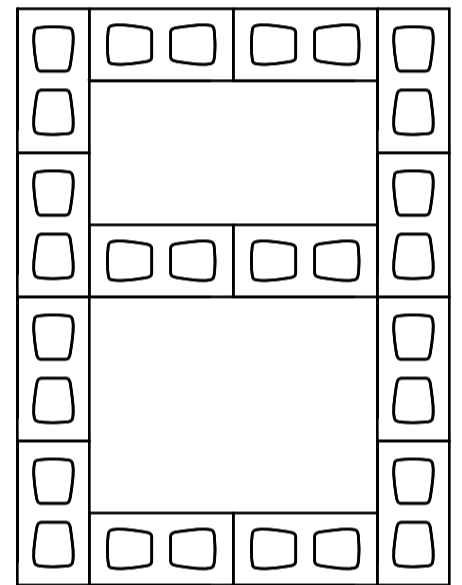
SECOND LAYER

of bricks: 14



THIRD LAYER

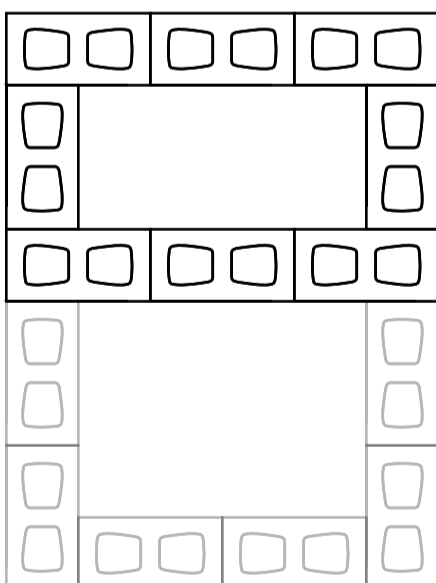
of bricks: 14



FOURTH LAYER

of bricks: 14

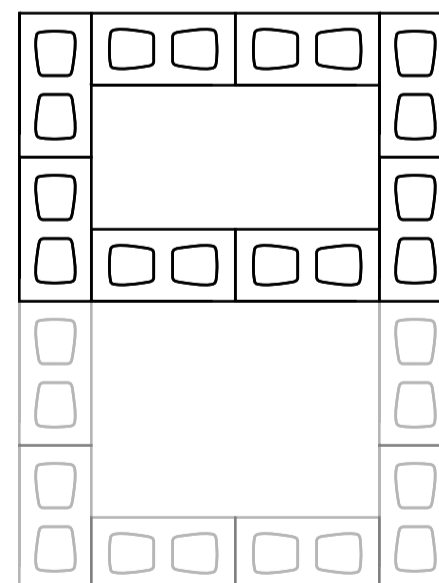
This is the final layer for the planter portion of the pencil holder.



FIFTH LAYER

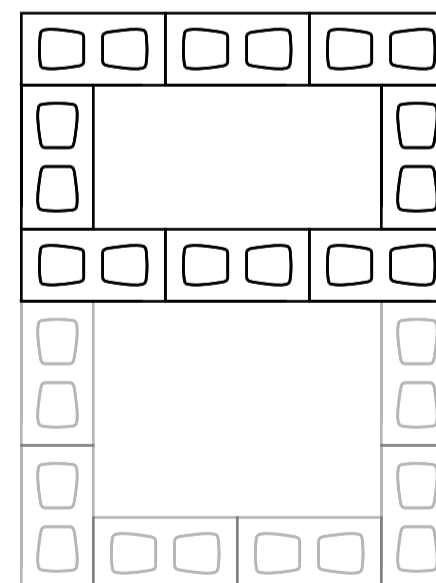
of bricks: 8

This layer will be continuing the pencil holder portion, above the 4 interior bricks.



SIXTH LAYER

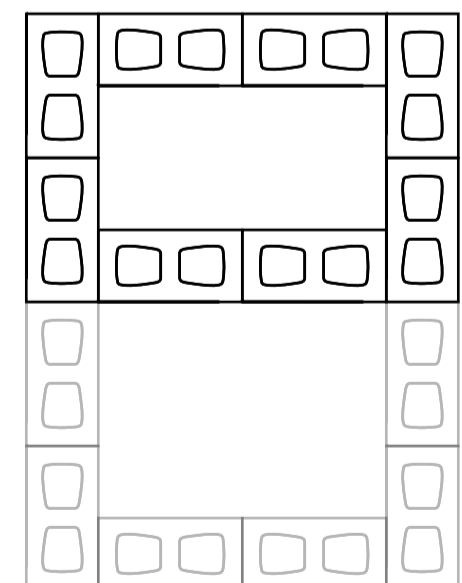
of bricks: 8



SEVENTH LAYER

of bricks: 8

You are almost done!



EIGHTH LAYER

of bricks: 8

This is the final layer! Yay! You are all done! Now just let the mortar dry and you will be ready to plant your succulent and add your pens and pencils!
