

**BECCA FEEKEN MAKE A SCENE  
CARD BASE ASSEMBLY**

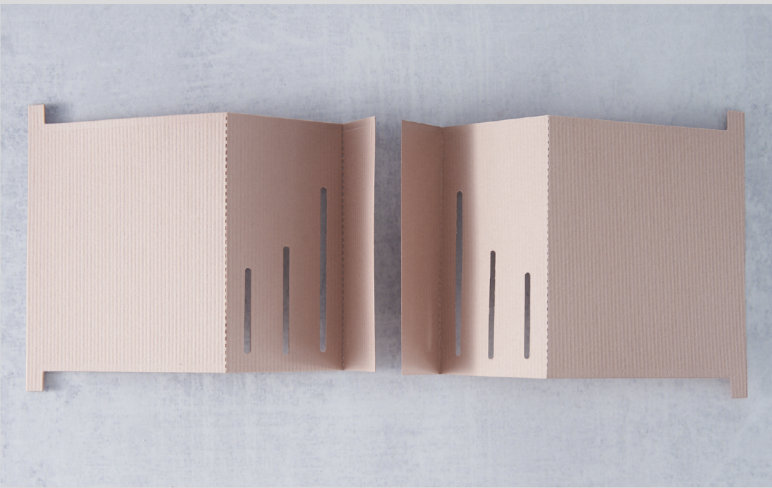
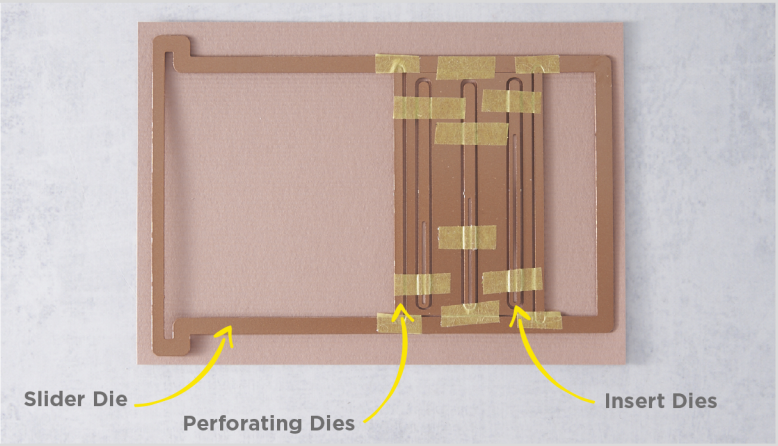
**Supplies**

• DIES: Make A Scene Card Base S6-165 • CARDSTOCK: Color Essentials Cardstock, 100lb Heavyweight • ADHESIVES: Best Ever Craft Tape SCS-123, Extra strength double sided tape • FINISHED SIZE: 5" X 7"

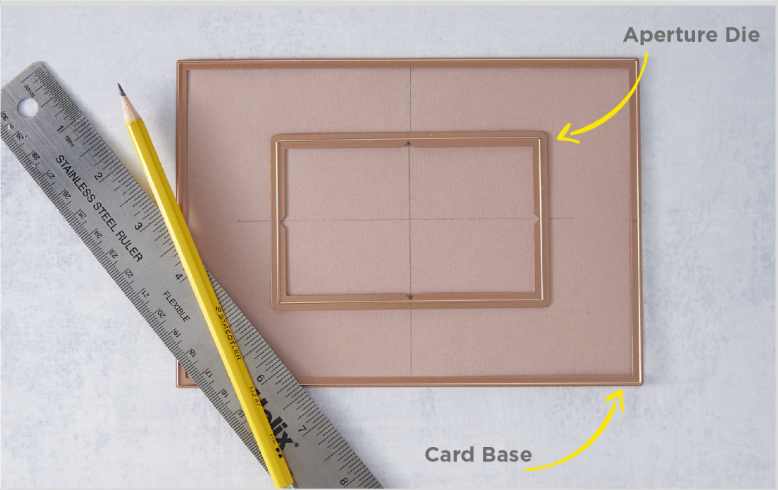
1. Trim (2) panels of heavyweight cardstock to 5" X 7". Arrange left side of Slider Die as shown with inserts and perforating dies tacked in place with removeable tape; die cut. To prep right side of Slider Die, remove (3) insert dies and rotate each die 180° degrees, again tacking in place with removeable tape; die cut.  
**\*Die cuts should be mirror images of each other.**

2. Gently fold each Slider Die on perforated lines as shown.

3. Die cut (2) Card Bases from heavyweight cardstock, remove cardstock from die and use Base die as guide to mark placement for aperture die by lining up the notches and score lines; die cut one Card Base with aperture.

4. Use Notch die to die cut both left and right sides of card front (Do not notch back of Card Base).

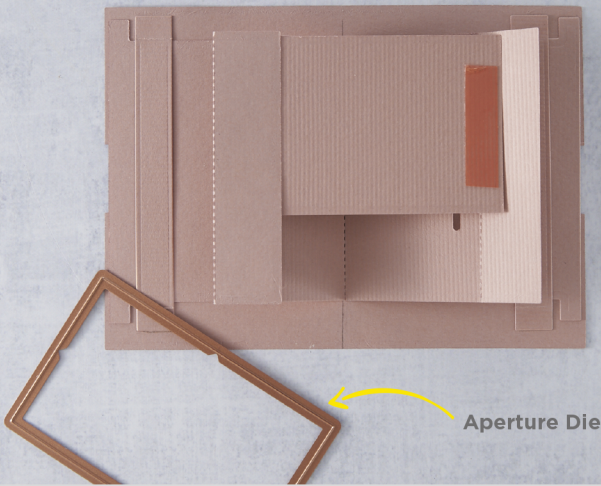
5. Begin card assembly by placing (2) folded Slider Die cuts on facedown card front; folded die cuts should also be facedown. With perforated fold meeting in the middle, tack left and right sides in place with removable tape (do not tape down folded areas).

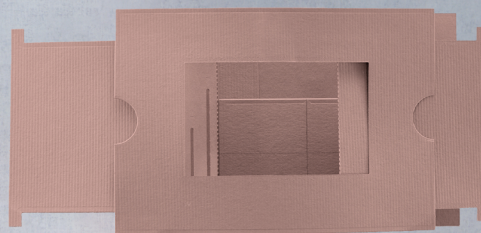
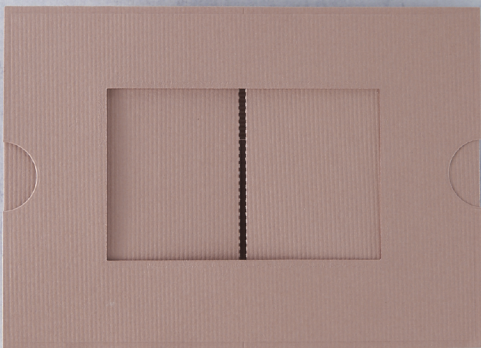
6. Die cut (2) Slider Guides from heavyweight cardstock and using strong tape, adhere in place to hold left and right Slider die cuts to card front. \*Make sure adhesive is only placed above score lines on Slider Guides.

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7. Using leftover piece from aperture die cut, place die cut under folded ends of Slider die cuts and adhere only along left and right side of die cut, as shown. Adding this extra die cut will add stability to your scene.

8. After gently closing card assembly, add strong tape to top of folded Slider die cut, as shown; remove tape liner, line up card base to card front and press firmly to adhere.



9. Turn card over to right side and - congratulations! You are on your way to creating your own special Make A Scene project. Your card base will open and close by pulling tabs on either side of card base assembly. Please see coordinating printable for instructions on adding inserts to your Make a Scene card base.
