Cash, check, and credit card!

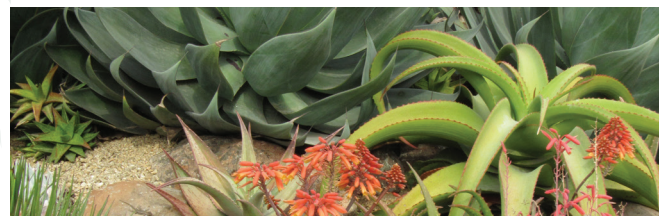
WHAT ARE THE FOOD OPTIONS?

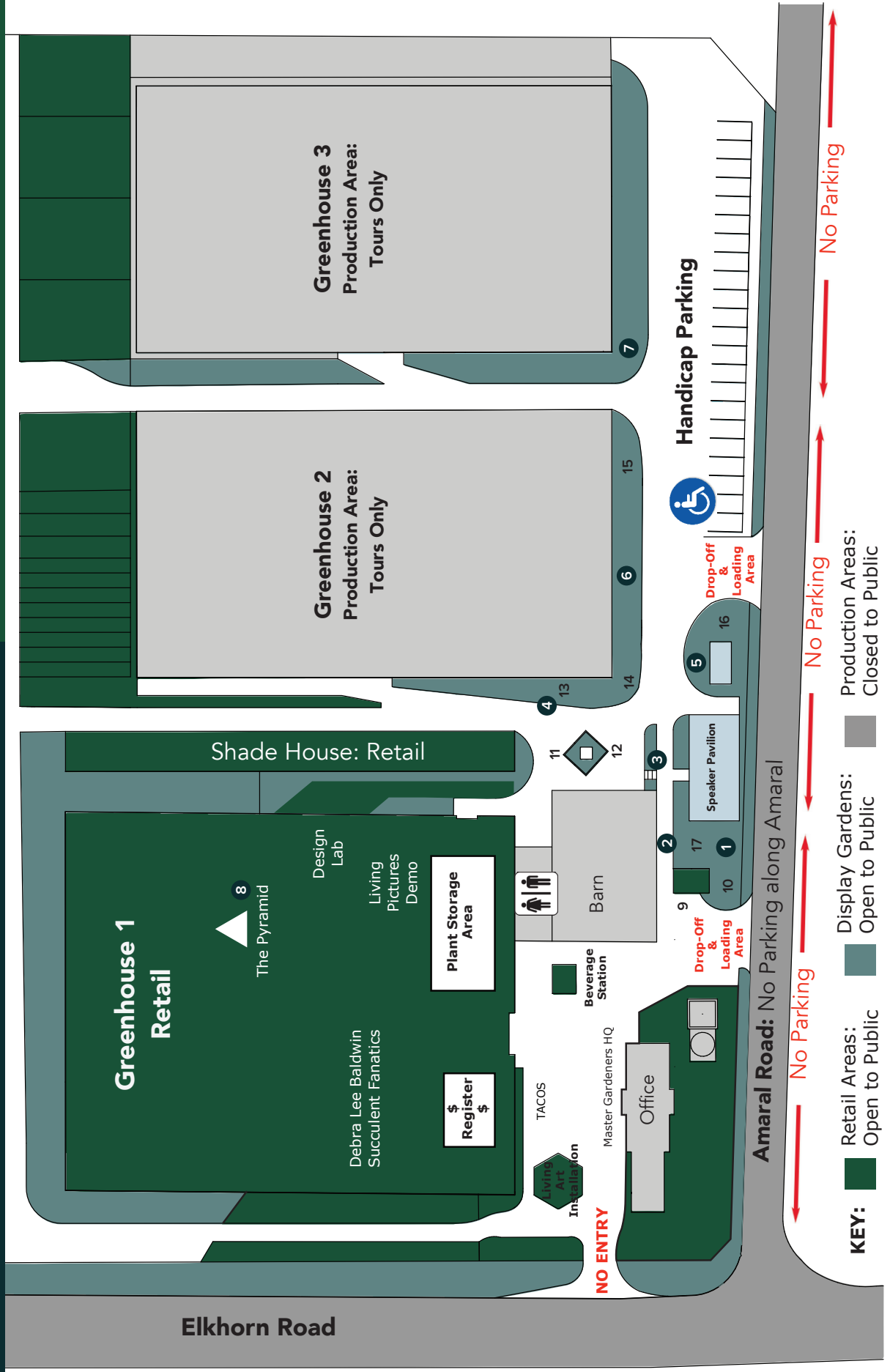
