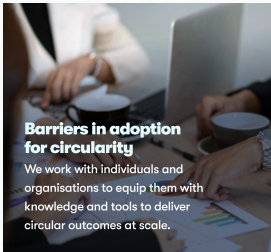

Development of a comprehensive asset log, using our exclusive software platform that tracks products and materials into their next life.

3

Rehoming of unwanted items, ahead of the major de-fit program to extend their use & reduce de-fit costs.

4

Disassembly & removal of loose items, including furniture, fixtures, fittings & conducting refurbishment ahead of their next use.

5

Completing soft demolition & make-good, in order to provide an end-to-end sustainable de-fit solution.

6

Deliver transparent impact reporting, through our exclusive software platform that includes avoided carbon analysis and circular outcomes.

Circconomy partnered with Mirvac to provide sustainable de-fit solutions across 12 floors, including furniture, flooring, ceiling tiles and other fixtures, resulting in 100% of items and materials from landfill along with a complete inventory of products and materials in our platform and environmental reporting.

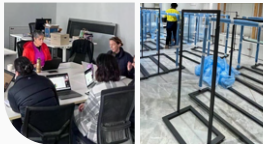
