Circonomy partnered with Mirvac to provide sustainable de-fit solutions across 12 floors, including furniture, flooring, ceiling tiles and other fixtures, resulting in 100% of items and materials from landfill along with a complete inventory of products and materials in our platform and environmental reporting.

Using our integrated software and a fivestage approach, the aim was to reduce the impact of commercial waste through reuse. refurbishment and repair of existing furniture and other items to prolong their lifespan.

Circonomy was engaged to complete the de-fit & make-good as part of the Eastland store closure. Our process involved the development of a full asset register to inform a rehomina strateau, disassemblu of store fixtures, segregation for store reuse and rehoming to small and medium business.
