MAKING THINGS BETTER

In supporting Brant United Way, you help **dozens of local services**, so they can be there when people need them most.

11,500 + people received a nutritious meal on a regular basis.

Over 125 families were given support they needed to stay strong during times of change.

620 people now have someone to turn to, so they don't have to face a crisis alone.

1,725 people were given a little extra encouragment and coaching to succeed at school or work.


A BALANCED APPROACH TO IMPACT
