! Site selection

- The unit is placed at least 10in away from the wall.
- Away from direct sunlight.
- Placed on a stable surface.
- A well ventilated area without excess dust.



⊘ Where it must not be installed

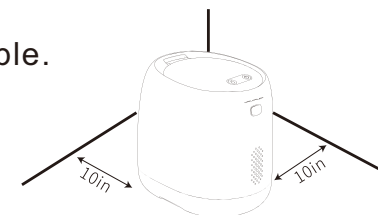
- Outdoors in sunny, windy and rainy places.
- A place where gas and dust tend to accumulate.
- A place with inadequate air circulation, blankets, poor ventilation, etc.
- Near stovetops or other heaters with open flames and high temperatures nearby.
- Near alcohol, petroleum, propane gas and other items that are easy to ignite.

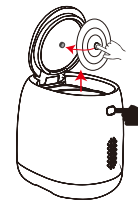
Instructions for first use



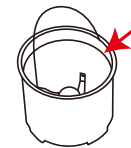
- 1 After closing the cover and connecting the power cord to the unit, insert the electrical plug into the AC power outlet. Blue lights flashing on the front of the machine indicates the unit is working normally. The buzzer will emit a startup sound.

Food Waste Treatment:

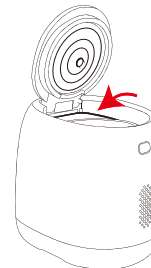
For normal food waste disposal, please follow the steps below.



- 2 Before using, affix the metal cover to the bottom side of the lid. Snap the metal with the rubber plug installed into the positioning column of the lower shell of the flip cover. Then use your thumb to press the rubber plug and rotate it clockwise (forward) half a turn to fix the metal cover to the bottom side of the lid.



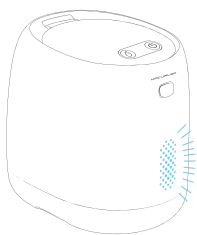
- 3 Strain out the water and oil from your food waste and put waste into the inner bucket. The amount of food waste should not exceed the indicator line on the upper part of the inner bucket.




- 4 Put the inner bucket into the main unit. Place the handle on the rear side of the chassis as shown.



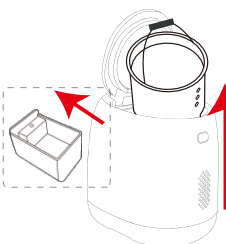
To be safe, be sure to follow these procedures



- 5** Close the upper lid and touch the  power button. The lower part of the fuselage will emit a blue light and the machine will start running.



- 6** After the processing is completed, the machine will automatically stop running and the lower part of the fuselage will be blue. The lights go out, but the fan motor will continue to work to cool until normal temperature is reached. You can press the  button or open the lid to stop the automatic cooling.



- 7** After opening the lid, make sure that the residual temperature of the machine is safe, and then remove the treated food waste from the treatment container and empty the water tray.

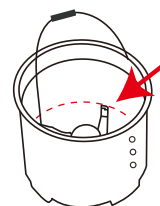
Precautions when using

During operation, the exhaust air may become hot and the main motor and surrounding may become hot. To avoid burns, do not touch.
If the main unit is moved or the cover is opened during operation, the safety device will be triggered and the operation temporarily interrupted.

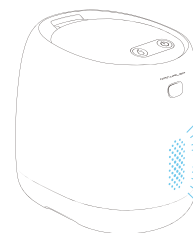

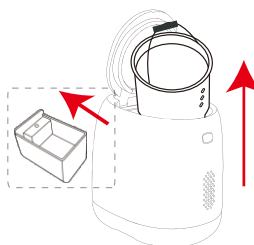
Cleaning mode: Pour the food waste out of the inner bucket. If you find that there is still food waste sticking to the bottom, perform the following steps. ☆ **The use of detergents is prohibited.** ☆



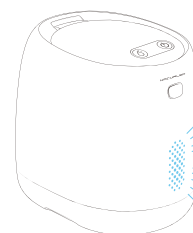
- 1** After pouring clean water into the bucket to the indicator line pictured, carefully place the bucket back into the machine. Do not spill water into the machine.




- 2** Close the lid and click the  key to start the auxiliary cleaning mode. At this time the blue light will come on and the machine is running.



- 3** After the machine finishes and you hear an alert tone, carefully remove the inner bucket and pour out the water. Residual food waste can be easily cleaned with a brush.

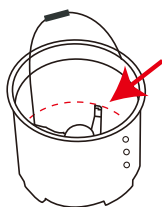


- 4** After the machine has been working for a long time, there may be distilled water in the black tank at the lower end of the filter. You can press and hold the  button for three seconds in cleaning mode to drain the water into the water tray.

Usage

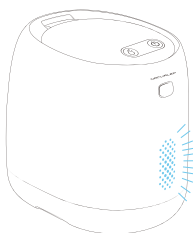
To be safe, be sure to follow these procedures

Activated Carbon Filter cleaning mode : The Activated Carbon Filter (hereafter called the Filter) will become saturated with order after it is used for a long time or some strong smelt food waste is processed. In this situation, the Activated Carbon Filter Cleaning Mode can be used to clean the Filter.

Make sure the bucket is clean before the operation. Refer to Cleaning mode on page 9 if the bucket is not clean. After pouring clean water into the bucket to the indicator line pictured, carefully place the bucket back into the machine. Do not spill water into the machine.

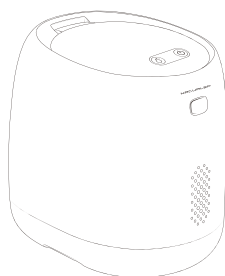

Close the lid and click the  and  keys at the same time for 3 seconds. The machine buzzes and the blue light turns on, breathing and igniting on in alternation. The machine generates steam to clean the Filter, and then dry the Filter, which takes about 3 or 4 hours. After cleaning process, the machine cools down with the blue light breathing. When cooling is completes, the light turns off.

Cleaning frequency: If the machine is used once or twice a day, it is suggested to clean the Filter once a week. Besides, if some strong smelt food waste is processed, it is suggested to clean the Filter immediately afterwards.

Note: The Filter is a consumable part. This cleaning mode only serves to relieve the reduction of the odor absorption ability. It can not address the gradual degradation the Filter's odor absorption ability. Processing decayed food waste will shorten the Filter's life significantly. So it is suggested not to proceed any decayed food waste at any time.



In order to use safely

This product is intended for household use. What can be dried is food waste from households.

- Please do not place anything other than food waste into the unit.
- Please do not use it for purposes other than food waste drying.
- It is recommended to filter the moisture and oil in the food waste before treatment.

Excessive oil content will affect the treatment time and drying effect.

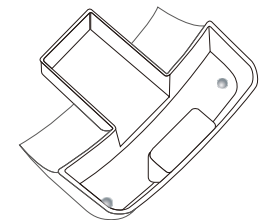

Processing time standards for better use

- This product evaporates water from kitchen waste through high-temperature drying and low-speed grinding. The exhaust is deodorized, filtered and discharged.
- The amount of food waste treated at one time should not exceed the indicator line in the upper part of the treatment container.
- The amount of food waste treated at one time should exceed the height of the lower mixing part of the treatment container.
- Rice, noodles, bananas, corn, potatoes and other food with high sugar and starch should not be processed on their own, but mixed with other kitchen waste. Otherwise, it may burn.
- Granular non-sticky food waste (peas, peanuts, corn kernels, beans) is easy to grind and should be mixed with other food waste.
- Processing times for vegetables and fruits, which have a lot of moisture, will take longer.
- Foods with high oil content, such as fish and fried foods, cannot be completely dried and will remain oily.
- In order to make the processing time more accurate, it is recommended to operate the machine after the food waste has cooled down to room temperature.
- If the drying is insufficient and there is odor overflow in the treatment, the filter element can be treated and replaced again.
- After use, please be sure to remove the treated food waste each time.
- The treated food waste can be used as raw materials for organic fertilizer. As the growth of plants requires balanced nutrients, it can be used well in horticulture.

○ About the big water tray

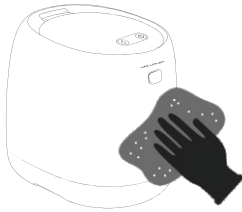

Maintenance Method

○ Outer shell

When the power is off, gently wipe the outside surface of the countertop garbage disposal with a damp rag, then use a dry rag to dry the surface of the machine.



! Warning

Never allow the console to soak in water.

○ Inner bucket

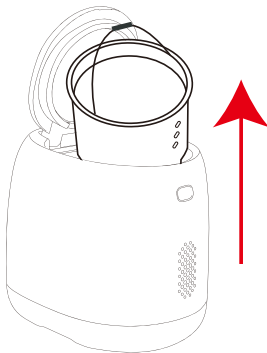
- It must be removed from the main unit before maintenance.

- Hand wash or dishwasher safe.

※ The inner bucket has a nano-ceramic coating.

Please do not clean or scrape with sharp objects to avoid damaging the coating and causing breakage

- Dry with a soft cloth after washing, or let it dry naturally.



○ Metal cover

- Metal cover must be removed from the main unit before maintenance.

- Grasp (pull) both sides of the rubber stopper with both hands and rotate counterclockwise. Take out the rubber plug after half a turn and remove the metal for cleaning.



Activated Carbon Filter

○ Replacement time of activated carbon filters

The replacement standard is once every 3-6 months.

Even if the replacement time has not yet arrived, if you start to worry about the smell, replace as soon as possible.

- Depending on the frequency of use and the type of food waste disposed of, there may be need for early or delayed replacement.
- Frequent processing of seafood such as squid and shrimp, or perishable food waste will shorten the life of the activated carbon filter.

○ Method for handling activated carbon filters

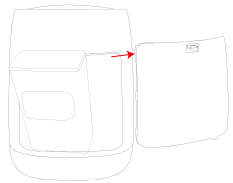
Please check the materials and processing methods used for the activated carbon filter before proceeding.

When the activated carbon filter is disassembled, it is easy for the carbon inside to disperse. Handle it outdoors and wear a mask, or cover the filter with a bag.

Activated Carbon Filter

○ How to replace activated carbon filters



- 1 Open the back cover, take out the cotton padding on the top of the activated carbon filter, then take out the activated carbon filter.

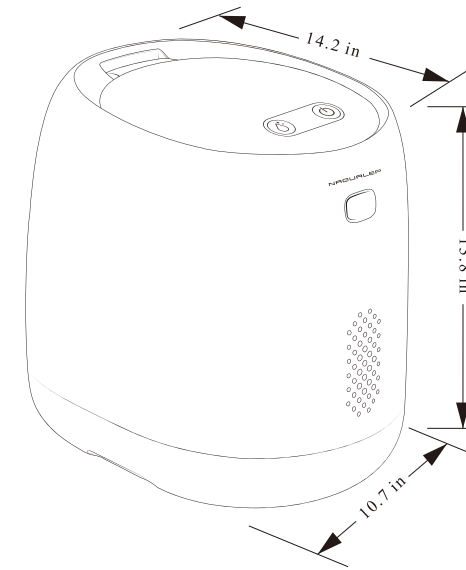


- 2 Replace with a new activated carbon filter (insert it at an angle of 45 degrees, align it with the rubber plug at the lower end, and press down to align it) and insert the cotton padding back to its original position.



- 3 Snap back the back cover.

Is it a fault?

Before inquiring about a service or repair, please check the following

Due to heat from operation, the chassis changes slightly	Heat transfer is transmitted internally and externally, this is a normal phenomenon	If the problem becomes severe, inquire about servicing from an authorized reseller
Steam from exhaust/a large amount of steam comes out of the air port.	Disposal of food waste which contains a lot of oil or water	It is recommended to process materials with lower amounts of oil and water
Processing time is too long	This can occur when processing large amounts of dense food waste	When processing a large amount of food waste, pay attention to the total density of the processed material
Food waste is not dry after operation	Lid was opened, halting operation	Resume operation and wait for the operation to complete.
	Underloading or overloading	Keep food waste above the minimum line and below the maximum line on the inner
