Pat coached teams won 8 National Championships, went to 18 Final Fours, and won 32 SEC Championships. And Pat was named "Coach of the Year" 15 times. Pat was the only individual to earn an Olympic medal both as a player (1976) and as a coach (1984).

Pat also wrote three New York Times Best Selling books; was named by U.S. World Report as one of the "Top 25 Most Influential Women Leaders" and named a Top 25 Most Influential Mother" by the White House.
