

Hazel Gate Set Up Instructions

Step 1:

- Unwrap your gate, and find the packet with hinges and screws. Assemble the hinges like so:



- The hinges may feel a little stiff at first but if you try and move them about they'll gain more movement.

Step 2:

- Screw the hinges into the gate, putting one hinge on each of the cross beams. They can be put on either side of the gate, although it may be worth planning which side will work best for you by visualizing how you would like the gates to open. For the screws in this pack you'll need a Star Key 40mm Bit.

Step 3:

- Screw the gate into a post. We recommend that you already have the post into the ground for this, as this will best allow you to judge the final height at which your gate will end up.
- To screw the hinge into the post, point it at a 45 degree angle to make sure that the gate is inline with the post. Make sure that the hinge attaching to the post is underneath the gate part, otherwise the gate will fall off. If you're confused, take a look at the images below where the incorrect and correct ways have been illustrated.



Lastly - check that your gate opens and closes. Open it a few times to make sure you have a full range of movement in the hinges.
