


A - Side Sections x2	Tools Required
B - End Sections x2	Cross Head ScrewdriverRubber/Soft Mallet<u>Please Note</u>
C - Feet	Number of 'Feet Parts' will vary
D - Base x1	depending on size of planter
Fixing Screws	



Step 1: Place 1st side section into end section, you may need to tap it in place with a mallet



Step 2: Locate the pre-drilled holes on both sections and fix in place with supplied screws





Step 3: Place 2nd end section onto 1st side section and attach with screws as in step 2.



Step 4: Now do the same with the final side section, you may need to tap it into place gently before fixing with screws.







Step 5: Turn the planter upside down and attach the feet using 2 screws per foot.



Step 6: Turn the planter over again so that it's upright and place the base section inside.





Your Planter is now complete!

- We recommend using a liner inside the planter before adding your compost and plants, this will help to prolong its life and protect it from rot.
- You can also use a wood preservative of your choice, or paint it in your preferred colour.
