Please follow this guide for instructions on how to properly clean your polyester fabric.

What You'll Need:

- 1. Mild detergent (Non abrasive or liquid laundry detergent)
- 2. Soft hair broom or brush
- 3. Sponge
- 4. Bucket
- 5. Soft towel or cloth
- 6. Hose
- Step 1: Stretch out the canvas and hang it on a clothesline.
- Step 2: Fill up a bucket with warm, soapy water.
- Step 3: Gently wash the fabric material with a soft hair broom or brush then rinse both sides of the canvas before allowing it to dry.
- Step 4: Leave the canvas outside until it is fully dry. Air and light will help speed up the drying process.

Your canvas is now clean and ready to be mounted back on the frame.

Warning! Do not use bleach to wash the fabric. Using bleach will create a chemical reaction that will cause the canvas to turn yellow or create other discolouration.

Do not fold or store the fabric while it is still wet. Storing the fabric while it is damp will cause mildew or stains that will damage the material and make the product unusable.
