How to use thread

The #25 floss is made by loosely twisting 6 thin threads. Pull out some of these thin threads and call it [\(\cap \) strands \(\).








1) Fold the thread in half and pull out the required number of threads





- What to prepare
- $_{\mbox{\scriptsize \textbf{d}}}$ For those who have a pattern (right side) that becomes a coaster when all stitches are finished, copy the finished line with a chaco pen.
- 2Cut the outside by 1.5cm from the finished line so that it becomes 13cm x 13cm



3 Fold the seam allowance in three




1) Back stitch

(2) Straight stitch

the stitch eyes are connected.



take out the needle from 1 and go back to 2 and go out to 3. The needle that came out in 3 repeats returning to 1.



Stitch the thread straight with one needle.

③ Outline stitch

Stitch that pierces the line where Stitch can be stitched with one It is a stitch that can pierce both straight lines and



Stitch from left to right according to the design. Go out from 1 and go into 2, put out 3 from the center of 1 and 2, and go back halfway at a glance. 2 and 5 are the same hole.

(4) Chain stitch

Stitches that make a thick line and connect rings like a chain.



Go out from 1 and go into 2, hook the thread from 3 on the needle and pull out the needle.


(5) French knot stitch Make a small knot. The size changes depending on the number of threads and the number of windings How to connect chains




Wrap the thread around the needle that came out of 1. Insert the needle vertically Prick the thread at the linto 2 near 1 and tighten the thread end of the stitch and let before pulling out the needle. Be careful it pass through the first not to loosen the tightening thread.

* Wind twice with this kit

(6) Fern stitch





Take out the needle from 1, enter 2 and exit 3. Stitch 4.5 and enter 6.

The needle passes through the hole 1 three times.

(7) Double lazy daisy stitch

Inside the Lazy daisy stitch, stitch a smaller Lazy daisy stitch. It can be applied in various ways by changing the pulling strength of the thread and the overlapping color.



Double lazy daisy stitch is a stitch that adds another same stitch inside the

(8) Rambler rose stitch


It is a stitch that stacks back stitches to make it look like a rose flower.



Stitch the threads from inside to the outside.

Ballion rose stitch

It is a stitch that pierces the bullion stitch in the shape of a rose



Hold the needle that came out in step 3 and wind the thread around the needle according to the length of the needle

Pull out the needle while holding the wound thread so that it does not come loose, and then tilt it toward you tighten the thread and enter 4.

This is called Bullion stitch.

Furthermore, multiple stitches are made from the center so that it becomes a rose shape.

(10) Bullion knot stitch

By applying Bullion stitch, it is a stitch that becomes a ball with a three-dimensional effect that is larger than French knot stitch




Go out of 1 and go into 2 on the immediate side, scoop a small cloth and pull out the needle from 3.

Wrap the thread around the needle that comes out, and while tightening the wound thread so that it does not come loose, enter 4 on the immediate side of 3.

* With this kit, wind 8 times.

(11) Bullion daisy stitch

With the application of bullion stitch. Stitch three-dimensional petals and flower cores.




Go out of 1 and go into 2 on the immediate side, scoop a small cloth and pull out the needle from 3.

Wrap the thread around the needle that comes out, and while tightening the wound thread so that it does not loosen, enter 4 near 2 and fasten it like a lazy daisy stitch. * With this kit, wind 18 times.


(12) Long and short stitch

Stitch that fills the surface by repeating long and short straight stitches. Unlike satin stitch, you can change the color of each step to express the color gradation.

Repeatedly stitch long and short straight stitches from the center of the first step to the outside. From the second step onward, stitch with a uniform length so that it slightly overlaps the short stitch on the first step.




(13) Satin stitch It is a stitch that fills the surface by arranging straight stitches



Stitch evenly so that the threads do not overlap along the lines of the design. When stitching a round object, stitch from the center to the outside and stitch the centers intersect.

(14) Fishbone stitch

Often used to stitch leaves.




Stitch from the outside to the inside along the line of the design so that
