### **1.WARRANTY**

### 2-Year Warranty

DIFFULL Corporation ("DIFFULL") warranty that the product shall be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of 2 years from the date of original purchase ("Limited Warranty Period"), provided the product was used in accordance with its use and care instructions (e.g., in the intended environment and under normal circumstances).

### **Your Limited Warranty Benefits:**

During the Limited Warranty Period and subject to this limited Warranty Policy, DIFFULL will, in its sole and exclusive discretion, either (i) refund the purchase price if the purchase was made directly from the online DIFFULL store, (ii) repair any defects in material or workmanship, (iii) replace the product with another product of equal or greater value, or (iv) provide store credit in the amount of the purchase price.

#### Who is Covered?







Brush retractable design can help you remove dust and hair from both upholstered furniture and hard surfacefurmiture.




### 3. Long Crevice Nozzle

Remove hair, rubbish and micro dust on the brush shaft to keep the bursh head clean.





- To avoid the dock dropping down, please make sure it must be installed firmly.























  The vacuum cleaner cannot be charged when the ambient temperature is above 40°C.


#### A. Remove the Battery Pack and Charge it Separately



#### **B.** Connect the Main Body to Charge




#### C. Hang on the Wall Mount to Charge

- 1. Press the dust cup release button to automatically empty the dust.
- 2. When using, if the garbage in the dust cup exceeds MAX Line, please empty it in time.






#### **WARNING**

### Clean the Dust Cup & Filter




## WARNING



- $\bullet \ \text{If you notice a decrease in suction power or if the filter is visibly dirty.} Please \ clean \ it \ promptly.$
- Wash the filter with cold water at least every month. Replace your filter every 3 months.
- Ensure that the Dust Cup and filter unit is completely dry before refitting.

### Clean the Rolling Brush

- 1. Remove the roller brush, clean the debris wrapped around the roller with Hair Cleaning Tool, then flush with water.
- 2. Insert the roller brush into the motored brush window, push down the cover it it securely in place.



#### **WARNING**



- To maintain optimum performance, check and clean the floor brush regularly.
- Ensure that the brush roller is completely dry before resting.
- The screen ijimii lights up in red to indicate blocked brushes, clear the blockages immediately.

### **6.TROUBLESHOOTING**

Problem	Possible Solution		
The vacuum doesn't work!	1. The motorized brush head is blocked with debris, clean the motorized brush head.  2. Auto protection for overheating, restart af cooling down.  3. Switch button can not work, contact our Customer Support for replacement.		
Weak or no suction!	1.Dust cup is full of garbage,empty the dust cup. 2The HEPA filter is blocked, need to be cleaned or replaced. 3.Extension tube or motorized brush head is blocked,clean the extension tube and motorized brush head. 4.Low power,charge the vacuum cleaner.		
Insufficient running time after charging!	1.Insufficient charging time, vacuum clean fully charged. 2.Battery aging, change the battery. 3.Motorized brush head or is blocked, clear the motorized brush head. 4.Charger is wrong, use the right charger.		

Problem	Possible Solution	
Charging indicator does not light up or flash abnormally!	1.Battery Pack is dead or broken, change the battery pack. 2.Charger is wrong, use the right charger.	
The Roller Brush stop rotating!	1.Brush Roller are blocked, Clean the Brush Roller and avoid picking up large rubbish. 2.Dust Cup is full of dust, empty the dust cup and contact our <b>Customer Support</b> for replacement.

### ATTENTION:

Before using this machine, please read all instructions in the manual and cautionary markings on the machine carefully.

#### To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury:

- 1.Please do not use the vacuum cleaner to vacuum deetergent, kerosene glass dreas, needles. wet items, sewage, matches and other itemns.
- 2. Please do not use the vacuum cleaner to vacuum toys, paper balls and other large objects, otherwise it will cause blockage of the vacuuum cleaner, motor burnout and other failures.
- 3. Please keep the vacuum cleaner away from fire and other hot places.
- 4. Please make sure to install the filter modules and theroller brush of the floor brush.
- 5. Please make sure not to block the suction inlet or block thee roller brush, as this may cause motor failure when using the vacuum cleaner.
- 6. Do not use it without filters in place.
- 7. Please do not pour or spill water or other liquids into the machine to avoid short circult and burn out the machine
- 8. Please fully charge the battery when using a new battery or the battery used for the first time after long-term storage.
- 9. Please ensure that it is charged and discharged at least every three months when the machine is not used for a long time.
- 10. The appliance is only to be used with the power supply unit provided with the appliance.
- 11. This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given superrvision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards inhvolved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenalnce shall not be made by children without supervision.

- 24. Disconnect the battery pack from the appliance before moking any adjustments changing accessories, or storing appliance. Such preventtive safety measures reduce the risk of starting the appliance accidentally.
- 25. For the purposes of recharging the battery, only use the detachable supply unit provided with this appliance. A charger that is suitable for one type of battery pack may create a risk of fire when used with another batteery pack.
- 26. Use appliances only with specifically designated battery packs. Use of any other battery packs may create a risk of injury and fire.
- 27. When battery pack is not in use, keep it away from other metal objects, like paper clips, coins, keys, nails, screws or other small metal objectts, that can make a connection from one ferminal to another. Shorting the battery terminals together may cause burns or a fire.
