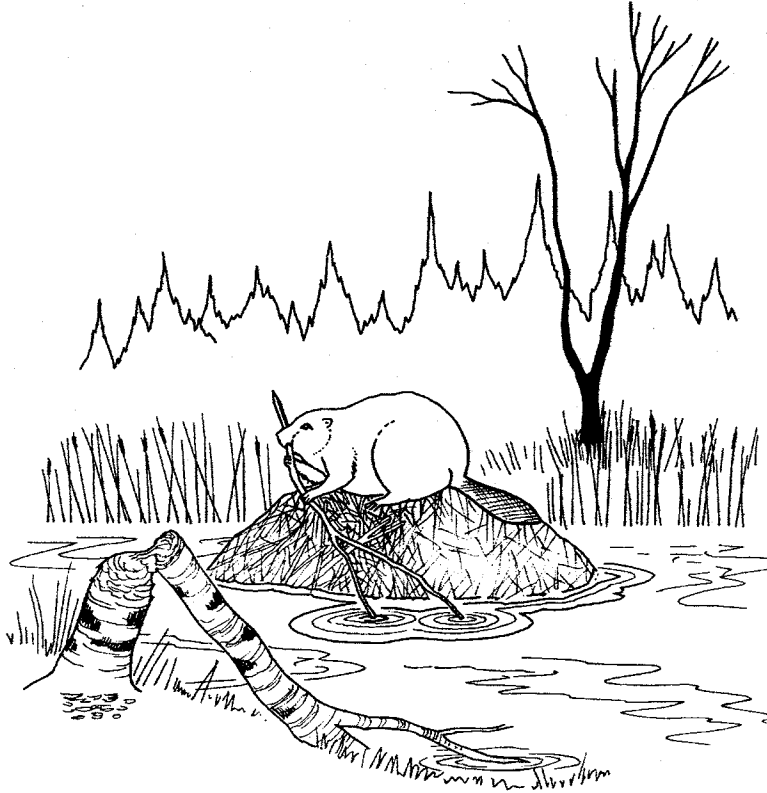
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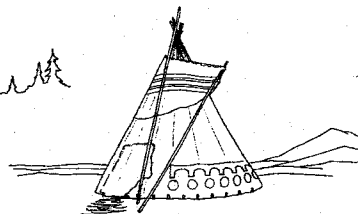
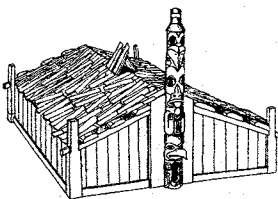
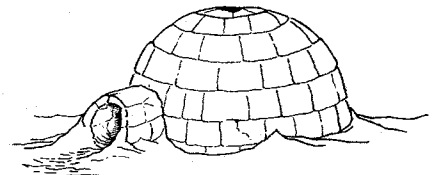
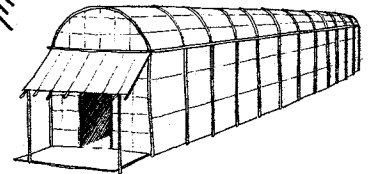
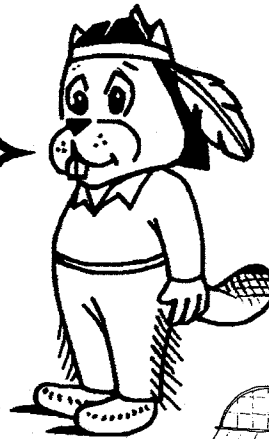
Introduction

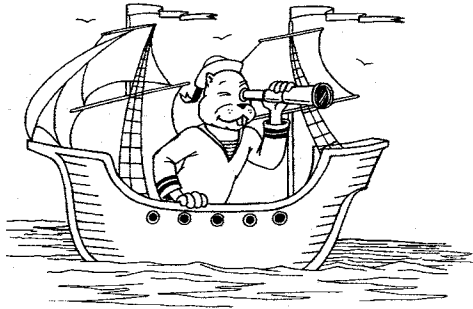

Many years ago the only people who lived in Canada were the Native People and the Inuit. They hunted and fished for their food.

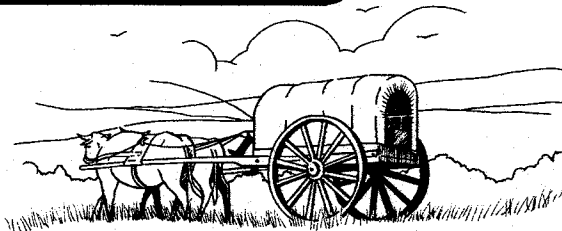
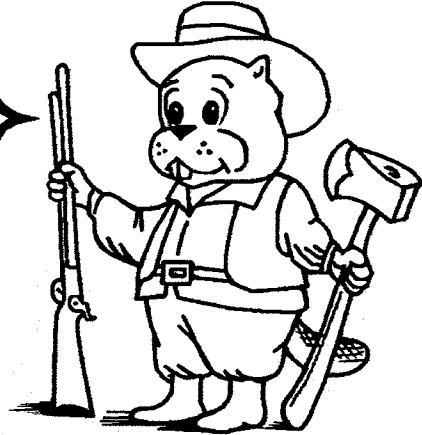

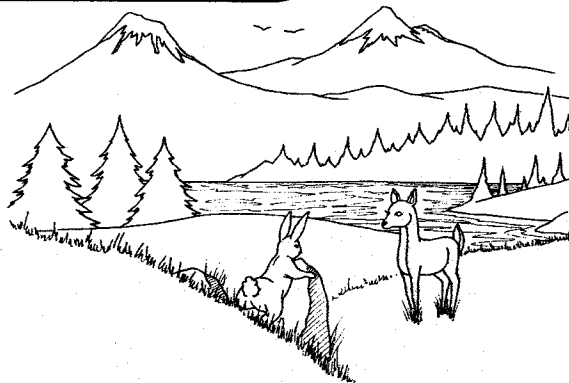




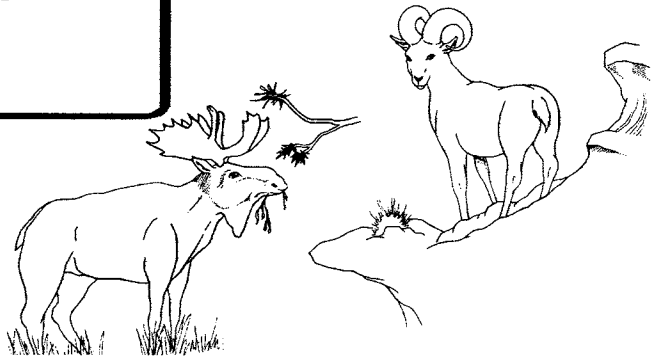
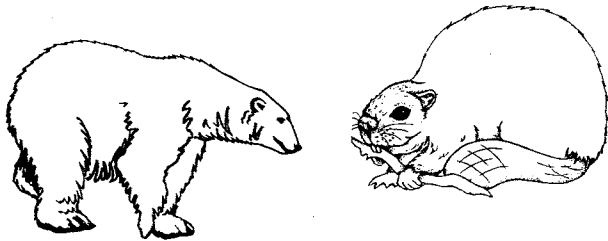
Canada is a big country.

forests.

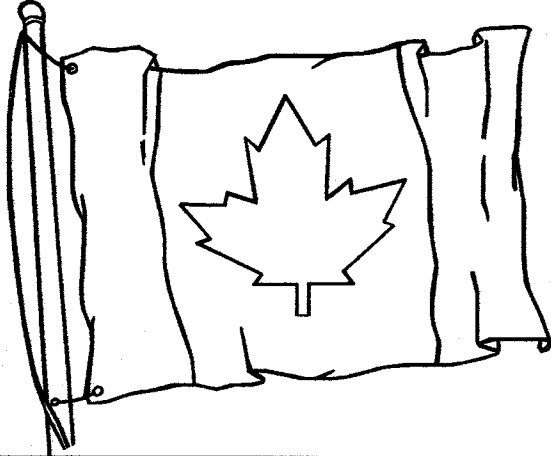


Canada has many animals.

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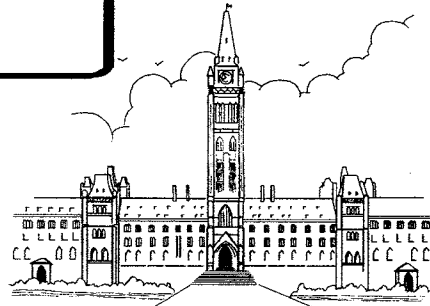
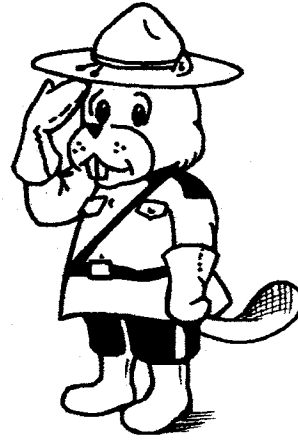
Many people live in Canada.
