The first is a letter from our very first Habitat Homeowners, who hope to tell potential sponsors and donors about the impact their Habitat Home has made on their lives. The second is from our thirteenth Habitat Homeowner whose story was written before becoming a homeowner in 2021.



## What a Habitat Home has meant to Habitat Family #1:

In 2002, I had a heart transplant in Toronto. We were living in southern Ontario with three young daughters for over a year so they could monitor me, which was extremely hard as our monthly rent payments were so high.

After a year, we were ready to move back to Sault Ste. Marie. There were limited options for a new place to live and we settled for a townhouse. We soon learned that the townhouse had a lot of mold and the electricity bills were extensive. We used up all of our savings over this year and a half in southern Ontario. We lost all hope of buying a house of our own, even after saving money all the years before.



Fortunately, we had been selected as the first family to receive the first Habitat for Humanity house partnership. In 2004, we moved in to our brand-new, safe, clean, and affortable house. We have raised three amazing daughters in this house and created so many amazing memories!!!

Over the years the house has meant **togetherness** for our family. The girls didn't have to move again and find new friends or attend another different school. We also felt more like a part of the **community** and neighbourhood because we owned our own home. Our house has meant **safety** for us knowing we have a new and clean place to raise our kids.. The house has meant **security** for us; it has helped us financially by allowing us to pay an affordable mortgage payment, especially as someone who has a limited income due to health issues. It allows us to **save a little bit for the future** of our growing family. It is our little egg nest that **we can always rely on**.

As we come up on having just two to three years left until we fully pay off our mortgage, we feel so many emotions and so much completeness as we know Habitat has made our dreams come true. We have been able to build a beautiful life and grow our family from five to ten. We are so grateful to have had this opportunity to partner with Habitat for Humanity Sault Ste. Marie & Area. We are all so proud to call this our home - not just our house... It's our Home Sweet Home!

## What a Habitat Home will mean to Habitat Family #13:

Growing up I had a childhood filled with change ... I moved often. I switched schools five times before the age of ten. I remember my mother telling me that I had probably moved 20 times by that age as well. Stability was lacking.

I remember never feeling settled anywhere. I remember not knowing what was going on in school because we often moved halfway through the school year. I had so many classmates and so many teachers that they all became a blur.

When I brought my children into this world, I knew I would face struggles and hardships as a single parent, but I also knew that I never wanted my daughters to know of any of this. I wanted to create that sense of safety in their world.

The first apartment I lived in with both of my babies was in an older part of the city - in a drafty, small, second-floor apartment. It was all I could afford and the only place that would take a single Indigenous mother on maternity leave.



One winter, rodents moved in and I would find their droppings all over the floors my young daughter would play on. After being awake all day with two babies, I would get them into bed and clean the house, do the dishes, and pick everything up off the ground. Then I would sleep for a few hours and wake up to feed the newborn and disinfect the floors and surfaces while checking traps for mice or rats.

Eventually, we moved into our current apartment. I attended my first lecture at Algoma University after being out of school for a decade. This apartment



is where I took a chance on school and found employment in my field and where I learned how to drive a car. We made a lot of great memories in this apartment but we have outgrown this space.

I am ready for this opportunity to move forward into this next chapter of our lives. I am excited to be given this help in becoming a homeowner. I work hard but the truth is that I am a single person, living on a single income, in a career that was started within the past five years.

Soon enough I will be assisting my children through post-secondary school and completing my goal of getting a master's degree in social work. As time goes on, I plan to open my own practice.

I am not trying to travel to see the world or buy designer bags. I am simply trying to do the work that I love while raising the people that I love in a positive, supportive environment.

Providing stability for my children means not moving to a new home every year and having the chance to build routines into our daily lives. Having a stable home that is mine means I can do this.

I am looking forward to having a home that we can settle into and grow in.
