

Wooden Wine Rack Assembly Instructions

Contents:

Metal Frame X 16
Wooden Rails X 16
Neck Protectors X 12




Please note that a Rubber Mallet is required for Assembly.

Step 1

Assemble two of the Metal Frames on a flat hard surface as indicated in the image on the right.

Take note of the orientation of the metal frames.



Step 2


Align these Metal Frames with the pre-cut grooves in the wooden rails.

Using a Rubber Mallet, insert the wooden rail half way into the metal frame. This is to ensure easy installation in the later steps.



Step 3


Continue this process to complete one side of your Wine Rack as shown in the image on the right





Once all of the Wooden Rails are in position, install another Metal Frame facing upwards along the top of the wooden rails. Continue this process until your Wine Rack looks like the image on the left.

Once again, only inserting the metal frame half way into the wooden rail.



Take care to ensure that these <u>Metal Frames align with the precut groves in the Wooden Rails</u> as seen on the right. This is to ensure easy assembly in the next step.

Step 5

Align the remaining Metal Frames and once again, only insert half-way.

Take care once again to ensure that all the notches in the metal frames align with the wooden rails. If not, minor adjustment of either the wooden rails or metal frames may be required.



Step 6 _____

Once all of the Metal Frames are in position, hammer down the Metal Frames until they are flush with the wooden rails.

If you find that the rack is not level, place a towel over the affected corner and lightly tap with the Rubber Mallet to align the off corner.

Your Wine Rack also comes with 6 plastic Neck Protectors. These clip onto the metal frame and protect the Wine Bottles as they are being placed in the Wine Rack
