

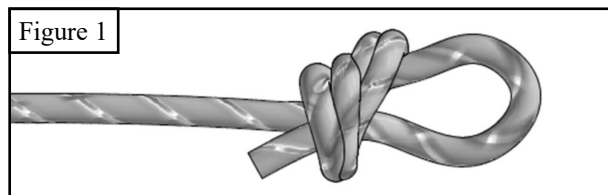
— SET UP INSTRUCTIONS —

VB1250K, VB1250KU, SVB1250K

- ◆ Inspect all contents prior to installation. Report any missing parts to dealer immediately.
 - ◆ Read all instructions before proceeding.
1. This net is designed to fit on a wide variety of systems with volleyball standards spaced between 34' and 40' apart. Bison recommends that standards are 37' apart center to center.
 2. The top rope has extra length to accommodate up to 40' standard spacing and may or may not have loops tied on each end at the factory. The top rope is tensioned by the winch on the selected volleyball system.
 3. The bottom rope also is extra long and has a crimped loop on one end and a rope ratchet tensioning device on the other end.
 4. After removing the net from the box, tie an overhand knot creating a loop on one end if not already done at the factory. Tie the knot compact and tight as possible. See Figure 1.



5. A second loop will need to be tied at the other end of the net. Location will depend on the distance between the poles and the actual volleyball system selected. It may take multiple tries to get the loop in the correct location to attach to the top rope winch strap to tension the net properly. Do not cut excess rope until you are 100% confident that your second loop is in the correct location. When satisfied, singe the cut end of the rope with a lighter.
6. When the top rope is tensioned, tension the bottom rope with the rope ratchet tensioner. The bottom rope is attached to the standards in different areas depending on the volleyball system selected. See system instructions.
7. You will note that when the top and bottom ropes are tensioned the net will slide back and forth between the standards. Follow the instructions provided with the small rope ratchet tensioner set included with the net, resulting in the net being centered between the standards and the net mesh being taut.
8. Remove any excess bottom rope leaving approximately 36" to pull on when tensioning the bottom rope. Singe bottom rope end.
