

MIRVITA OPIFICIUM ARTE VINO TOR DE FALCHI








"Here is a new and exciting producer from the Castel del Monte area in the northern part of Puglia. Tor de' Falchi is an up-and-coming reality located in Minervino Murge near Andria. It farms 11 hectares of vines and is specialized in Nero di Troia, Aglianico, Moscato, Fiano and Bombino Nero. They make 150,000 bottles per year now but have plans to expand to 300,000. The winery is heavily involved in the arts and in the promotion of Puglian culture".

MIRVITA OPIFICIUM ARTE VINO TOR DE FALCHI "AETAS NOVA" 2012 CASTEL DEL MONTE NERO DI TROIA RISERVA DOCG



With 15,000 bottles produced, the 2012 Castel del Monte Nero di Troia Riserva Aetas Nova is a balanced and forthcoming wine that offers generous fruit and spice that wrap smoothly over the palate. The fruit balance is spot-on and those earthy and slightly rustic tones of Nero di Troia emerge with confidence. In the mouth, the wine offers some sour, mouth-puckering liveliness.




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Showing very attractive artwork on the label, the 2012 Castel del Monte Aglianico Animae Agri is a balanced wine with no hair out of place. Dark fruit and dried blackberry is woven within a thicker fabric of exotic spice and leather. The wine offers a generous and upfront personality that would pair with spicy meat dishes

CASTEL DEL MONTE BOMBINO NERO DOCG




Tor de' Falchi claims that this wine hails from Italy's first DOCG Rosato appellation. Since I cannot think of another, I'm happy to introduce the 2015 Castel del Monte Bombino Nero Rosé Suprematism under this headline. Following in the great tradition of rosé wines from Puglia (that existed many decades before the denomination rules were implemented), this wine offers fresh raspberry and white cherry with natural spice and bitter almond on the close.

MIRVITA OPIFICIUM ARTE VINO TOR DE FALCHI "SANTALOJA" 2015 MOSCATO SECCO IGP PUGLIA



The owners of Tor de' Falchi are pretty excited about this wine and it is easy to see why. The 2015 Moscato Secco Santaloja is an explosively fragrant and floral white wine that would taste great at aperitivo time when the sun sets over a beautiful seaside panorama. This is an unabashedly Mediterranean wine with a powerful and lasting bouquet. The mouthfeel is thinner and more compact in comparison.
