## ENGAGEMENT RING AFTERCARE



Do not wear your ring in a swimming pool or hot tub as the chemicals in the water can react with the metal.

Remove your ring when applying lotions as these dull the sparkle of your 'Diamonds'. Allow perfumes and lotions to dry before wearing.





Avoid wearing your ring whilst sleeping as this puts pressure on the band and can bend the shank and prongs out of shape. Your ring can also catch onto your blanket damaging the prongs causing stone loss.



Avoiding wearing your ring whilst performing vigorous activities such as gardening and a gym workout to avoid breaks, splits, cracks and loss of stones.



Always handle your ring by their band and avoid touching the diamond as fingers are covered in oils that can dull the sparkle of your Diamonds:



Store your rings separately in a jewellery box or fabric pouches so they won't scratch and protect them from bends and breaks.







## LEANING



The 'Diamonds' becomes dirty and cloudy looking due to grime and oil residues originating from fingers or skin contact. As the muck builds up on the surface, it can severely hamper the 'Diamonds' ability to transmit light properly.



Even a thin film of oil on a 'Diamonds' facet can completely change the angles in which light refracts and reflects; resulting in lower brilliance and sparkle. This is why keeping a diamond clean is so important!



Try soaking your ring in a solution of warm water and dish washing liquid for about 20 mins.



Remove the ring solution and start cleaning it with a soft bristle brush. Clean all sides of the 'Diamonds' by brushing gently with the bristle brush. Since dirt normally builds up at the edges and the back of the ring in normal usage, you might want to give these areas an extra scrub.



After brushing, place the ring back into the solution of water and detergent. Brush the ring within the solution to wash off the loosened dirt.

Use a soft cloth to gently dry your ring.



- Another effective way of cleaning your ring by using an ultrasonic cleaner (Some cost as little as £30 from Amazon). This machine uses ultrasonic waves to help clean your jewellery using vibrations to dislodge oil, dirt and everything in between.
  - · You just pop your ring into the basket (it also works for jewellery, watches and glasses), fill it with water and set the machine to run for under 10 minutes.
    - · Remove your ring and gently dry it down with a soft cloth.

Do NOT use an ultrasonic cleaner for any gemstone jewellery.
