About Active Mic Cable

Active Mic Cable is a mic cable specially designed for dynamic microphones (moving coil / ribbon) which has active buffer circuit inside XLR(F) plug.

With controlling the electromagnetic braking that dynamic microphones have, it will achieve the wider dynamic range. The active buffer circuit that place immediately after the microphone output will provide best impedance conversion and signal transmission from electrical and physical sides.

■ CAUTION!

There is no user serviceable components in Active Mic Cable.
Do not strip down the circuit, it will be broken.
Stripping down the cable will void the warranty.

Instructions

Please feed 48V phantom power from microphone preamp or mixer to power the preamp circuit. There will be loud noise on switching phantom power on/off, so be sure to turn down the volume.

- ★ If there is no sound please check following.
Is the phantom power of mic preamp or mixer ON?
Some mixer has an overall phantom on/off switch in addition to the individual switch for each channel, so please check the mixer's instructions too.
- ★ Active Mic Cable looks exactly same as normal microphone cables. If there is another operator at your studio, be sure to inform him or her that this cable needs phantom power.
