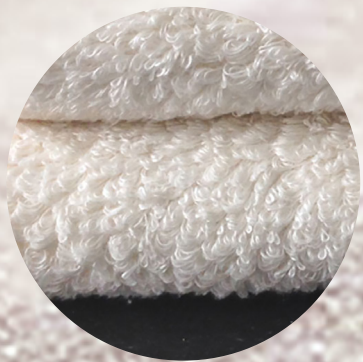
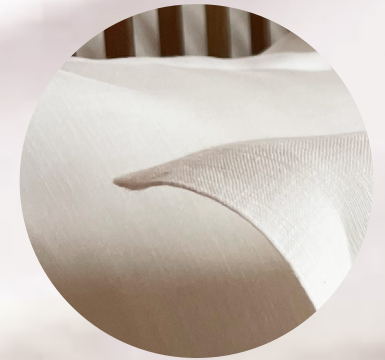

## HEMP – WHY?

Always fragrant & long-lasting:

Antibacterial, hypoallergenic, odour-inhibiting, long-lasting, insulating, moisture-wicking, UV-protecting. – Add a nice, clean feeling and you already have the ideal fabric for always fragrant terry towels, cool, dry bed linens and much more.

Always organic & sustainable:

Neither chemicals nor irrigation is needed for perfect growth of Industrial Hemp. On top, hemp only needs 1/3 of land, compared to cotton. Hemp absorbs 4 times as much CO2 per Ha as cotton and twice the amount of a mature forest\*.

After a US-ban in the 1930es, Industrial Hemp or True Hemp, is again entirely legal and cherished all over the world.

## HEMP COPENHAGEN

Hemp Copenhagen Co. was founded in 2017 as a brand, producing home textiles and accessories. The idea was to build on the personal luxury-aspects of hemp, notably the antibacterial qualities.

Hemp is still a rare commodity. Less than 1% of world production of textiles.

We supply branded goods to retailers and consumers, and increasingly white-label or co-labeled, customised products to larger customers, including the hospitality industry.

We have defined our “planetary mission” to be to help increase the share of hemp textile to at least 50% of world production.

You can help us and the planet with this mission, simply by buying hemp textiles and at the same time add a little extra magic to the experiences of your guests.



# HEMP LUXURY TEXTILES. HOW THEY ARE MADE.



## HARVEST

2-4 meter stalks are machine-harvested & bundled manually



## RETTING

Stalks are soaked in water 4-6 weeks, manually attended.



## FREEING FIBRES

From dried stalks. Manual w. special equipment.



## COMBING

Removing pectin and other impurities manually.



## SPINNING

From here, weaving etc. on conventional equipment.

## PRODUCTION

Hemp cultivation and production is vastly different from other natural fibres, like cotton. The growth more or less takes care of itself, i.e. no fertilizers, chemicals or irrigation is needed. The other steps, however, requires considerable time and manpower.

Only semi-optimal machinery exists for harvest. Then you need 4-6 weeks for retting, in water ponds (ca. 200 L/kg fibre). This process is monitored manually, resulting in shades of grey, beige to white. The longer you ret, the brighter the fibre and final textile.

Fibres can then be "hammered" free" from the dried stalks and combed. Then the yarn can be spun to thread. Then, weaving, knitting and sewing is done on conventional equipment, used for e.g. cotton.

## ORIGIN

Our hemp textiles come primarily from Transylvania, Romania (EU), where our knitting, weaving and sewing-operations are situated. Fibres also come from Ukraine and the Baltics. All these countries have a long tradition of producing hemp textile, un-broken by the US ban of hemp from the 1930ties which only recently have been lifted.

All our products are hand-sewn, by very skilled sewers, resulting in finished products that match the unique qualities of the fabric itself. Workers are paid fair wages under conditions and workplace-rules of the European Union.

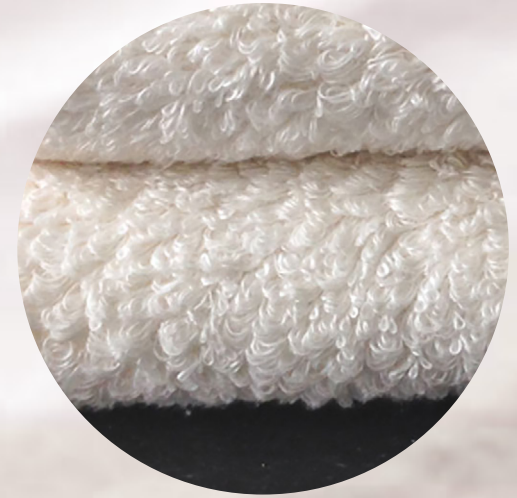
*Now, you really can ask your guests to use their towels more than once (to help save the planet, of course).*

Unlike cotton towels, True Hemp terry towels can stay for weeks in damp bathrooms, closed-up golfbags and still come out smelling like a meadow!

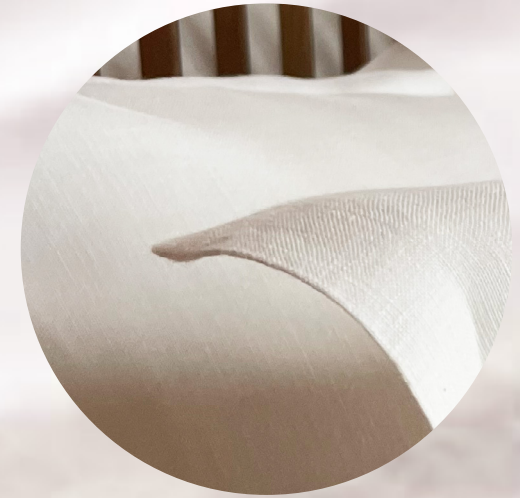

Sources: EU, UN, UNESCO and others. Figures are global averages. E.g., cotton requires an average of 10,000 liter water per kg fibre grown. Global average rainfall is 5000 liter/kg cotton (or per 3,4 m2), leaving a need for irrigation of 5000 liter water/kg cotton. Hemp requires 2000 liter/kg, leaving zero need for irrigation, on average.

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# CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

Items are tested for professional wash and care:

Plain weaves (bed linen, pillowcases, napkins etc)

- Wash up to 80 °C\*
- Roll-iron up to 180 °C
- Use a de-calcifier for hard water.

Terry (Towels, bathrobes):

- Wash up to 60 °C
- Tumble-dry till semi-dry, then line
- Or tumble at low heat
- Use a de-calcifier for hard water.

Knits (Bathrobes):

- Wash up to 40 °C
- Tumble-dry till semi-dry,
- Or tumble at low heat
- Use a de-calcifier for hard water.

\* Normally, 30-40 °C is sufficient for all fabrics as the fabric rarely needs to be disinfected. 60°C is needed to remove fat-stains etc.

We provide full instructions, for you or your laundry partner, specific to items bought.



# FULL CIRCULAR: RECYCLING:

If we want to give our planet or rather – ourselves and our children – a chance, Recycling is one of the most important tools.

Recycled textiles use zero scarce resources like land and irrigated water (some for production)– as opposed to new textiles.

For hospitality, recycled natural fibre textiles are rarely an option. If one wants fresh, natural fibre textiles, hemp is the best solution: 1/3 of farmland, compared to cotton, no irrigation needed. No chemicals needed.



Although hemp textiles lasts 3 times longer than most other natural textiles, eventually, it will have to be disposed. Or rather: recycled.

In Denmark we offer to work with Convert A/S who recycles textile waste into e.g. building materials or materials for furniture-making. – The cost of sending the waste to a normal incineration plant in Denmark is ca. 150 USD/tonne + Transportation. Convert A/S offers to take the textile-waste for ca. 75 USD/tonne + transportation.

With this model there is a clear economic incentive to recycle, instead of sending waste to incineration or landfill.

Proximity to the recycling facility is of course paramount in order to minimise cost and CO2-emissions. – Max sustainable transportation distance is around 150 km.

The recycling industry with these types of solutions is developing rapidly. A great number of local recycling plants will emerge all over the planet in a span of few years. This will make the recycling supply-chain more and more efficient and sustainable with time.

So, with the longevity of hemp textile, chances are we will be able to help you find close-by partners from our growing network of recycling partners.
