
LOCAL DISH TO DREAM

UNWRITTEN RULE THE

LOCALS LIVE BY Enjoy a typical kaffeehaus (Viennese coffee house) at least once a day.

MUST-YISIT MUSEUM The Albertina Museum Vienna (albertina. at) to see wonderful paintings and the Habsburg State Rooms, the former residence of the daughter of empress Maria Theresa and her husband.

A SOLO ACTIVITY Take a horse and carriage tour through the historic inner city.

FOR A TASTE OF ROYALTY

Tour the Schönbrunn Palace, the former summer residence of the Habsburg family located in the Hietzing district. Back in town, visit the Hofburg castle, the city residence of the Habsburgs.
