CHOOSING SOLID TIMBER

With solid timber, after years of hard wear in any environment, a simple re-sand and re-coat will bring your floor back to its original condition. Because of the depth and solidity that a traditional solid timber floor has to offer, it can be re-sanded many times. Depending on the timber, you can even change the 'look' of it with the multiple colouring options that are available. This is why it is said that solid timber is a sustainable source that will outlast your own lifetime in your home. It is this very reason that it's usually an instant advantage when it comes to selling your home or project. CHOOSING AN ENGINEERED TIMBER

Unlike a solid timber floor, 'pre finished' or engineered timber is as it sounds, finished when it leaves the factory. These floors are usually a 4-6mm engineered timber veneer glued to a 10mm ply backing. A high wearing clear finish is applied at the factory. Or, we can supply you with what is called an 'unfinished' engineered board, that gives you the freedom to choose how it's sanded, coloured and coated. The dimensional stability means there is less need to accommodate for seasonal movement and humidity when installing with a reduced acclimatization period. Engineered flooring can be applied directly to sub floors with underfloor heating. Freedom Flooring supply high quality engineered flooring, as we like our customers to be happy with their choice for many years to come.

STAIRCASES

Spiral, curved, L shaped, straight, or light them up like a Christmas tree! Timber staircases for us are a thing of beauty and often attract comments from friends and visitors as they can be objects of grandeur.

Staircases provide a way to travel from one floor to another in a home or commercial building and therefore receive a high amount of foot traffic throughout the year. Timber should be the material of choice for designers and homeowners seeking internal staircases of strength, beauty and durability.

PARQUET

In 1684, a new type of flooring was introduced in Versailles, France. This flooring was made by hand cutting small pieces of various coloured hardwoods into geometric shapes using squares, triangles, and lozenges. The word Parquet was given for creating and installing wooden flooring this way.

Initially, the level of skill and artistry required to make Parquet made it extremely expensive and it would appear only in the homes of the most affluent and royal families. Now - although time and great artistic skill is still required to lay it - the abundance of wood products combined with the latest technology makes Parquet more affordable than it's ever been.

Parquet is now available in both solid and engineered form making it available for a wide range of applications. The three dimensional nature of Parquet works in every environment, from rustic to the most modern decor. There has been a huge resurgence in the popularity of Parquet with the most common forms being Herringbone and the Chevron pattern.
