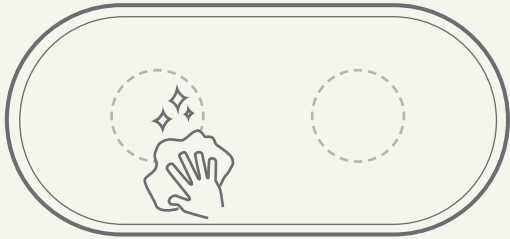


# Installation Guide: Verona Concrete Dining Table

READ THROUGH ALL THE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE YOU BEGIN INSTALLING YOUR BLEND CONCRETE DESIGN TABLE

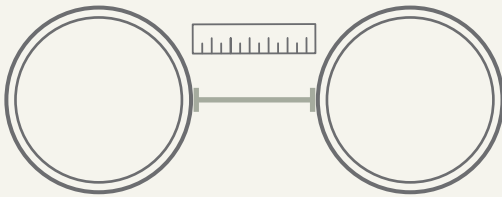
BOTTOM VIEW

Use a dry cloth to wipe the top of the two cylindrical legs and the under side of the concrete tabletop

You will see that there are two circles drawn on the underside of the tabletop. These circles are a guide to help you position the legs. Be careful not to wipe the circles off.

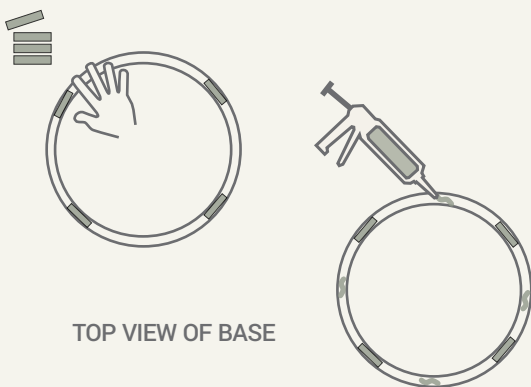
TOP VIEW OF BASES

Position the two legs 800mm apart

TOP VIEW OF BASE

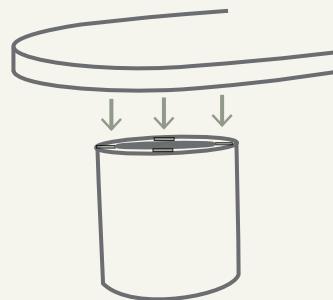
Peel off the adhesive sticker from each foam strip and apply them to the top of the table's base.

**Optional:**

- You can also apply a bead of silicon in the areas between each pad for a more permanent construction.
- These foam strips can also be attached to the bottom of the table's base to prevent the concrete from scratching delicate floor surfaces.

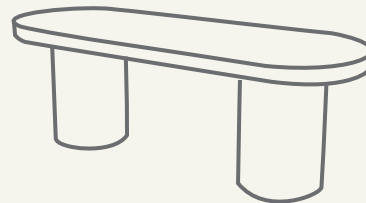
When performing step 04 please be aware that the tabletop weighs approximately 135kg. Make sure that you have a sufficient number of people to help with the lift and positioning of the table top. Remember to use best practice lifting techniques.



Use the circles drawn on the underside of the table as a guide.

Lift the tabletop and place it on the legs.

Once the tabletop has been placed on the legs, check that the legs are positioned within the circles drawn on the underside of the tabletop. If required, adjust the legs so that they are positioned within the circles.
