# BLOSSOM FLOWERS



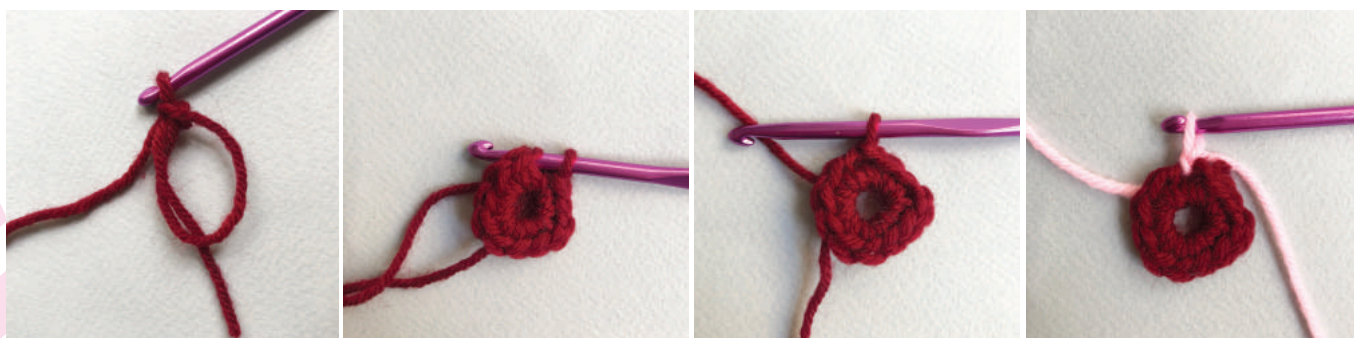

YOU WILL NEED:  
10G YARN, TWO COLOURS FOR EACH BLOSSOM  
CROCHET NEEDLE SIZE 4.5  
TAPESTRY NEEDLE  
SEWING SCISSORS

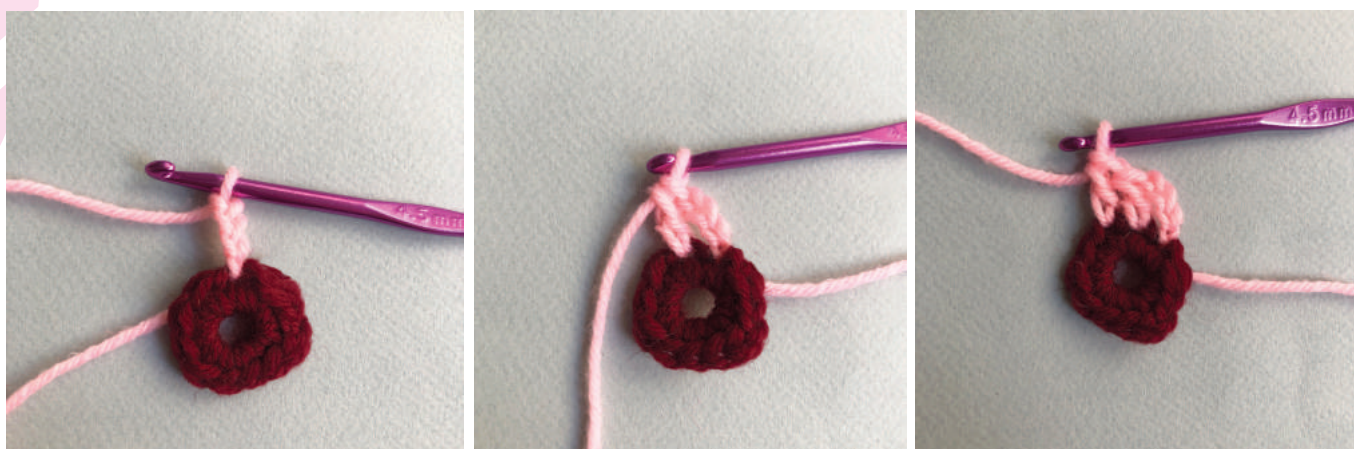
ABBREVIATIONS  
SL - SLIPSTITCH  
CH - CHAIN  
TR - TREBLE CROCHET  
ST - STITCH



TO BEGIN CREATE A MAGIC CIRCLE, BY WRAPPING THE YARN AROUND TWO FINGERS, CROSSING OVER AT THE TOP. TAKE THE CROCHET HOOK AND PULL BACK THE YARN UNDER THE FRONT YARN.



ROW ONE - CH 1. DC 11 STS INTO THE MAGIC RING. SL TO JOIN. CHANGE YARN COLOUR.



ROW TWO - THE PETALS. IN SAME ST CH 3. IN NEXT 2 ST, 1 TR. NEXT ST 1 TR, THEN CH 3. SL TO JOIN TO NEXT STITCH.





**NEXT PETAL... IN SAME ST CH 3. IN NEXT 2 ST, 1 TR. NEXT ST 1 TR, THEN CH 3. SL TO JOIN TO NEXT STITCH.**

**REPEAT FOR ALL FOUR PETALS THEN CAST OFF.**

**MAKE SURE ALL ENDS ARE WELL KNOTTED AND YOU CAN STITCH THEM BACK INTO THE WORK BEFORE TRIMMING DOWN FOR A NEAT FINISH.**

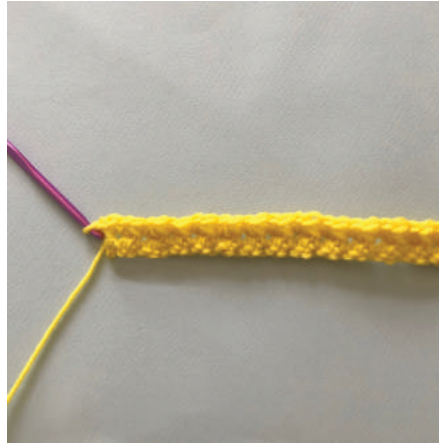
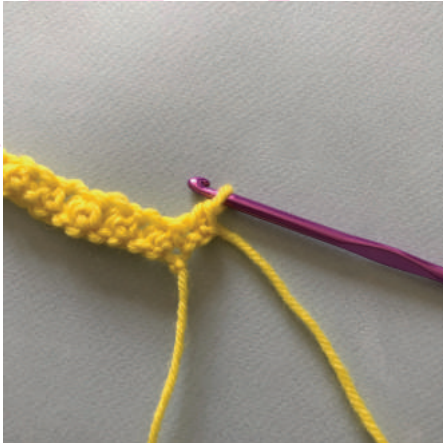

**100G YARN  
CROCHET NEEDLE SIZE 4.5  
TAPESTRY NEEDLE  
SEWING SCISSORS**

**CH - CHAIN  
DC - DOUBLE CROCHET  
DC3TOG - DOUBLE CROCHET THREE  
TOGETHER  
ST - STITCH**



**TO CREATE THE HEADBAND**

**MULTIPLE OF 2 STS + 1, PLUS 1 FOR THE FOUNDATION CHAIN. HOW TO MAKE A SC3TOG: INSERT HOOK INTO CH INDICATED, YARNOVER, PULL UP LOOP (KEEPING IT ON THE CROCHET HOOK) THEN REPEAT 2 MORE TIMES IN NEXT 2 CHS. YARNOVER, PULL THROUGH ALL 4 LOOPS ON HOOK.**

**ROW ONE - CH THE WIDTH OF YOUR HEAD IN MULTIPLE OF 2 CHS.**

**DC IN 2ND CH FROM HOOK.**

**DC3TOG STARTING IN THE SAME CH AS PREVIOUS ST**

**CH 1, JOINING ALL FOUR LOOPS TOGETHER**

**REPEAT ACROSS THE ROW UNTIL THE LAST CH, ALWAYS BEGINNING IN THE SAME CH AS PREVIOUS ST**

**AT THE END OF ROW, 1 DC IN THE SAME CH AS THE 3RD LEG OF THE PREVIOUS ST, TURN.**

**ROW TWO - CH1,**

**1 DC IN THE FIRST STITCH,**

**DC3TOG STARTING IN THE SAME CH AS PREVIOUS ST**

**CH 1, JOINING ALL FOUR LOOPS TOGETHER**

**REPEAT AS LAST ROW UNTIL THE LAST CH, ALWAYS BEGINNING IN THE SAME CH AS PREVIOUS ST**

**AT THE END OF ROW, 1 DC IN THE SAME CH AS THE 3RD LEG OF THE PREVIOUS ST, TURN.**

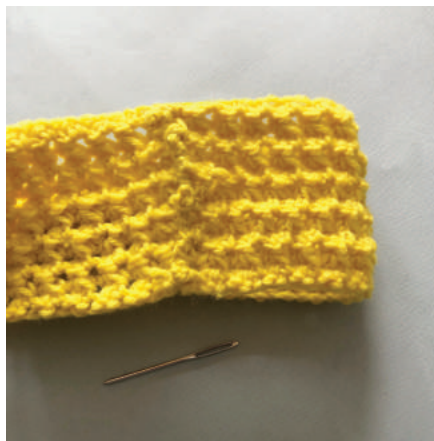
**REPEAT FOR 9 MORE ROWS (11 IN TOTAL), THEN CAST OFF.**





**TO CREATE THE CENTRE OF THE HEADBAND**

**ROW ONE - CH 16 + 1  
DC IN SECOND CH FROM HOOK  
DC UNTIL THE END OF ROW, TURN  
ROW TWO - CH 1,  
DC IN THE SECOND CH FROM THE HOOK  
DC UNTIL THE END OF ROW, TURN  
REPEAT FOR 8 MORE ROWS (10 IN TOTAL), THEN CAST OFF.**



**TO STITCH UP HEADBAND**

**USING THE TAPESTRY NEEDLE STITCH ENDS OF YARN BACK INTO THE WORK THEN TRIM TO A FEW CMS.**

**TO JOIN THE SIDES, TURN THE PIECE THE WRONG WAY AROUND AND FOLD IN HALF LENGTHWAYS. USING THE SAME YARN, KNOT THEN STITCH ACROSS THE SEAM. TIE A KNOT AT THE END AND AS BEFORE STITCH THE LOOSE ENDS INTO THE WORK. TURN THE RIGHT WAY AROUND.**

**THREAD ONTO THE HEADBAND.**

**TURN THE HEADBAND THE WRONG WAY AROUND AND STITCH UP SIDES IN THE SAME WAY.**

**TURN RIGHT WAY AROUND AND PUSH THE CENTRE PIECE OVER THE SEAM.**

**NOW YOU HAVE YOUR GORGEOUS HEADBAND TO KEEP YOUR EARS NICE AND COSY!**





**HEART POMPOM  
EARRINGS**



**ADORABLE POMPOM HEART EARRINGS WITH A SPRINKLE EFFECT THAT YOU WILL LOVE TO WEAR AND MAKE AS A GIFT**

**YOU WILL NEED:  
10G YARN, FIVE COLOURS OF CHOICE  
POMPOM MAKER 45MM  
TAPESTRY NEEDLE  
SEWING SCISSORS**



**WRAP THE 5 COLOURS OF YOUR CHOICE AROUND THE POMPOM MAKER UNTIL YOU FILL THE CURVE. DO THIS FOR BOTH SIDES OF THE POMPOM MAKER. RUN THE SCISSORS UP THE CENTRE, SNIPPING THE YARN AS YOU GO. USE A 20 CM PIECE OF YARN TO TIE THE POMPOM IN THE MIDDLE, PULL IT FIRMLY. TIE THE KNOT TWICE.**



**PULL THE POMPOM MAKER OPEN AND PULL IT APART GENTLY. TRIM THE POMPOM UNTIL IT FORMS A HEART SHAPE. RUN THE TAPESTRY NEEDLE THROUGH THE POMPOM WITH WHITE YARN.**



**ATTACH THE WHITE YARN TO A FISHHOOK EARRING AND TIE A KNOT TO SECURE IT. THESE CUTE EARRINGS ARE NOW READY TO ADORN YOUR EARS!**





## HANGING HEARTS



**THIS LOVELY PROJECT MAKES BEAUTIFUL 6CM WIDTH HANGING HEARTS. PERFECT TO DECORATE AN ARRAY OF INTERIORS.**

**YOU WILL NEED:**

**10G YARN**

**CROCHET NEEDLE SIZE 4.5**

**TAPESTRY NEEDLE**

**SEWING SCISSORS**

**ABBREVIATIONS**

**SL - SLIPSTITCH**

**CH - CHAIN**

**TR - TREBLE CROCHET**

**DTR - DOUBLE TREBLE CROCHET**

**HTR - HALF TREBLE CROCHET**

**ST - STITCH**



**TO BEGIN CREATE A MAGIC CIRCLE, BY WRAPPING THE YARN AROUND TWO FINGERS, CROSSING OVER AT THE TOP. TAKE THE CROCHET HOOK AND PULL BACK YARN UNDER FRONT YARN. ROUND ONE - CH 2 15 TR INTO THE MAGIC CIRCLE. SL INTO THE TOP OF THE FIRST TR.**

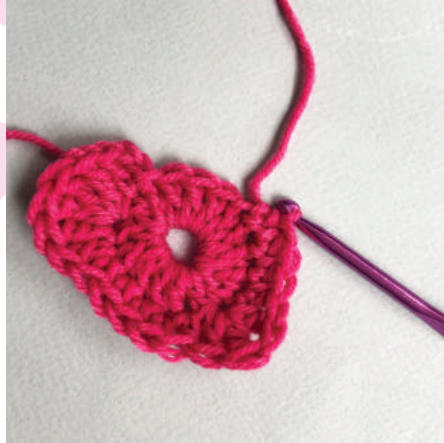
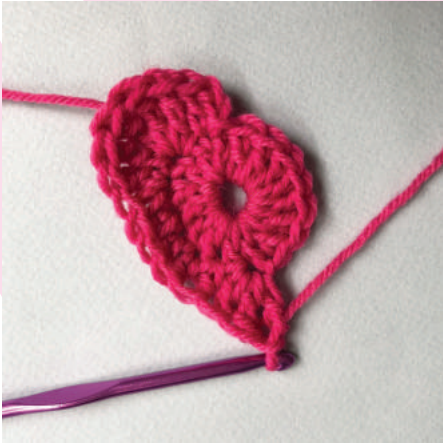


**ROUND TWO - CHAIN 2. 1 TR INTO THE SAME STITCH. 4 DTR INTO NEXT STITCH. 2 TR INTO NEXT STITCH. 1 HTR INTO EACH OF NEXT FOUR STITCHES. TO CREATE THE POINT, 1 TR, 1 DTR, 1 TR INTO NEXT STITCH.**



**REVERSE STITCHES UP THE OTHER SIDE OF HEART. 1 HTR INTO EACH OF NEXT 4 STITCHES, 2 TR INTO NEXT STITCH, 4 DTR INTO NEXT STITCH, 1 TR INTO NEXT STITCH, CHAIN 2, SLST INTO SAME STITCH.**





**TO CREATE A HANGING LOOP, PULL THROUGH THE SL TO ABOUT 4CM LENGTH AND USE END OF YARN TO TIE KNOT. PULL THE MAGIC CIRCLE FULLY CLOSED.**



**FINISH BY THREADING ENDS THROUGH BACK OF WORK AND TRIMMING DOWN.**





# POMPOM KEYRING



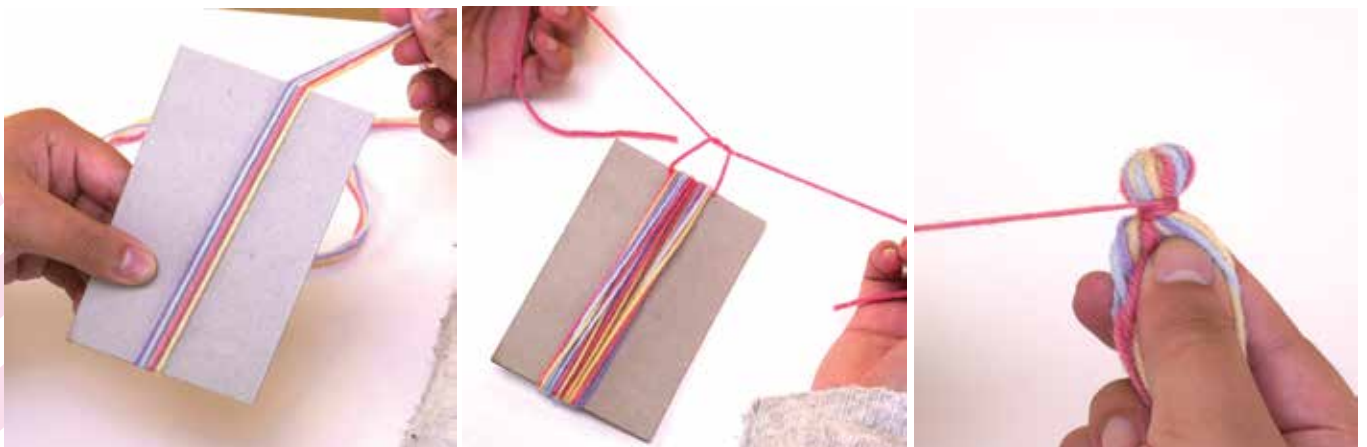


**THIS CUTE POMPOM CHARM MAKES A GREAT KEYRING OR BAG ACCESSORY AND ITS DECEPTIVELY EASY TO MAKE.**

**YOU WILL NEED:  
100G YARN, COLOURS OF YOUR  
CHOICE  
TAPESTRY NEEDLE  
LOBSTER CLASP  
POMPOM MAKERS 45MM & 35MM**



**MAKE 2 SOLID COLOUR POMPOMS USING THE 45MM & 35 MM POMPOM MAKERS.**



**USING A PIECE OF CARDBOARD AS A GUIDE, WRAP COMPLEMENTARY YARN COLOURS AROUND IT ABOUT 5 TIMES. WITH A PINK PIECE OF YARN TIE A KNOT. REMOVE THE TASSEL FROM THE CARDBOARD AND TIE A PIECE OF PINK YARN TO MAKE THE HEAD FOR THE TASSEL. TIE IT QUITE FIRMLY.**



**TRIM THE END OF THE TASSEL. THREAD A PIECE OF YARN THROUGH THE TASSEL AND POMPOMS. TIE A KNOT AT THE END OF THE PURPLE POMPOM AND ATTACHED THE LOBSTER CLASP. ENJOY WEARING YOUR CHARM!**



## MUG COSY





**KEEP YOUR CUPPA COSIER FOR LONGER WITH THIS SIMPLE PATTERN.**

**YOU WILL NEED:**

**10-20G YARN FOR MUG ( DEPENDING  
ON WHAT SIZE IT IS), 10 G FOR  
CONTRASTING EDGES  
CROCHET NEEDLE SIZE 4.5  
TAPESTRY NEEDLE  
SEWING SCISSORS  
TAPE MEASURE ( YOU CAN USE A STRIP  
OF YARN TO MEASURE)  
MUG**

**ABBREVIATIONS**

**SL - SLIPSTITCH  
CH - CHAIN  
DC - DOUBLE CROCHET  
TR - TREBLE CROCHET  
ST - STITCH**



**TO BEGIN YOUR PROJECT, YOU MUST CHOOSE THE MUG YOU WOULD LIKE TO MAKE THE WARMER FOR. THIS PATTERN WORKS FOR STRAIGHT SIDED MUGS AS WELL AS ONES WITH A LITTLE SHAPE AS THE YARN HAS SOME STRETCH. THIS WON'T WORK FOR MUGS WITH A LARGE DIFFERENCE IN CIRCUMFERENCE BETWEEN TOP AND BOTTOM. MEASURE UP!  
MEASURE THE CIRCUMFERENCE OF THE MUG LEAVING A 5 MM SPACE FROM THE HANDLE EITHER SIDE. AND THE HEIGHT LEAVING ABOUT 2CMS OFF THE OVERALL MEASUREMENT.**

**CH THE CIRCUMFERENCE AS MEASURED, PLUS 2 FOR FOUNDATION CH  
ROW ONE - 1TR IN THE 4TH CH FROM THE HOOK  
1 TR IN EVERY CH UNTIL THE END OF THE CHAIN, TURN**

**ROW TWO - CH 3 ( COUNTS AS FIRST ST)  
1 TR IN EVERY TR UNTIL THE END OF THE ROW, INSERTING HOOK FROM FRONT TO BACK UNDER BOTH  
LOOPS OF EACH ST.  
AT THE END OF ROW CH 3 AND TURN**



**FOLLOWING ROWS - REPEAT THIS UNTIL YOU REACH THE MEASURED HEIGHT OF YOUR MUG AND CAST OFF.  
THREAD THE ENDS OF THE YARN BACK INTO THE WORK BY ABOUT 3CM AND TRIM.  
TO FINISH - CHOOSE A CONTRASTING COLOUR OF YARN  
DC ALL ALONG THE TOP OF THE WORK, WHEN YOU GET TO THE END PLACE WORK AROUND THE MUG AND  
CH THE NUMBER OF STS IT TAKES TO JOIN TO THE OTHER SIDE. REMEMBER A SUNG FIT IS BEST.  
REMOVE FROM MUG TO FINISH.**





**SL TO THE TOP OF THE FIRST STITCH AND CAST OFF.  
REPEAT THIS AT THE BOTTOM OF THE WORK.**

**STRETCH OVER THE MUG AND ENJOY A NICE BREW!**







# PENCIL CASE



**THIS ADORABLE PENCIL CASE IS EASY TO MAKE AND LOOKS GORGEOUS WITH THE ADDITION OF A CAREFULLY CHOSEN BUTTON!**

**YOU WILL NEED:**  
20G OF YARN, PLUS 10G IN  
CONTRASTING COLOUR  
CROCHET NEEDLE SIZE 4.5  
TAPESTRY NEEDLE  
SEWING SCISSORS  
BUTTON

**ABBREVIATIONS**  
SL – SLIPSTITCH  
CH – CHAIN  
DC – DOUBLE CROCHET  
ST – STITCH



**THIS PATTERN COMPRISES OF THREE SECTIONS, TWO FRONT AND BACK PANELS AND THE FLAP. TO CREATE THE FRONT AND BACK PANELS: ROW ONE – CH 28 + 1. DC INTO THE 2ND CH FROM THE HOOK. DC ALONG THE WHOLE ROW, AT THE END CH1, TURN. ROWS TWO TO ELEVEN – REPEAT ROW ONE. REPEAT THIS PROCESS TWICE FOR THE FRONT AND BACK PANEL. TO NEATEN ENDS, STITCH BACK INTO THE WORK BY A FEW CMS AND TRIM.**



**TO CREATE THE FLAP: ROW ONE – CH 28 + 1. DC INTO THE 2ND CH FROM THE HOOK. DC ALONG THE WHOLE ROW, AT THE END CH1, TURN. ROW TWO – REPEAT ROW ONE.**



**ROW THREE – (HERE IS WHERE YOU START TO REDUCE YOUR WORK). MISS THE FIRST ST DC ALONG THE ROW UNTIL THE 2ND FROM LAST STITCH, SKIP THIS, CH1 AND TURN.**





**ROW FOUR - MISS THE FIRST 2 STS AND DC INTO THE 3RD ST. DC ALONG THE ROW UNTIL THE 3RD ST FROM THE END, SKIP 2 STS, CH 1 AND TURN. ROWS FIVE AND SIX - REPEAT ROW FOUR AND AT THE END CAST OFF. NEATEN END OF THE YARN BY USING TAPESTRY NEEDLE TO STITCH INTO THE WORK AND TRIM.**



**ATTACHING THE WORK - STITCH THE WIDTH EDGE AND THEN THE SIDES OF THE PENCIL CASE FRONT AND BACK TOGETHER STITCHING THROUGH BOTH SEAMS. IF YOU DO IT THIS WAY AROUND YOU AVOID ANY DISCREPANCIES IN SIZE DUE TO TENSION. NEXT ATTACH THE FLAP FACING RIGHT WAY. USE THE CONTRASTING WOOL COLOUR. DC ALONG THE FLAP. STITCH THE BUTTON INTO PLACE.**



**CREATE A BUTTON HOLE. CH THE LENGTH THE HOLE NEEDS TO BE IN THE PENCIL CASE YARN COLOUR. ATTACH BOTH SIDES USING SL JUST UNDERNEATH THE EDGE OF THE FLAP. NOW IT'S TIME TO FILL WITH YOUR FAVOURITE PENS AND PENCILS OR EVEN A CROCHET NEEDLE OR TEN!**

PLANT POT  
100G YARN, ANY COLOURS OF YOUR  
CHOICE  
PERMAFIX TAPE  
SCISSORS



TO BEGIN, CLEAN YOUR PLANT POT AND USE PERMAFIX TAPE ALONG THE HEIGHT OF THE OUTSIDE OF THE POT.



USING YOUR FAVOURITE COLOURS, WRAP THE YARN AROUND THE PLANT POT UNTIL YOU HAVE THE DESIRED EFFECT. YOU CAN EVEN ADD MINI POMPOMS AS AN EXTRA TOUCH.





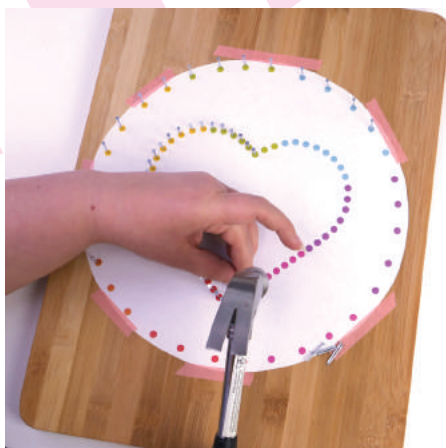
## WALL ART





**THIS COLOURFUL WALL ART LOOKS SUPER STRIKING – AND IT’S SURPRISINGLY EASY TO MAKE! FANTASTIC TO BRIGHTEN UP YOUR HOME, OR AS A FUN GIFT FOR A FRIEND.**

**YOU WILL NEED:  
CHOPPING BOARD  
100G YARN, RAINBOW COLOUR  
SELECTION  
NAILS, HAMMER & TEMPLATE  
SCISSORS**



**TO BEGIN, TAPE THE TEMPLATE SECURELY ONTO YOUR CHOSEN BOARD AND CAREFULLY HAMMER A NAIL INTO EACH DOT, MAKING SURE THEY ARE ALL ROUGHLY THE SAME HEIGHT.**

**ONCE THERE'S A NAIL IN EVERY DOT, TIE YOUR FIRST COLOUR ONTO A NAIL AND START WRAPPING IT RANDOMLY BETWEEN THE INNER AND OUTER NAILS IN THAT SECTION – WE'VE COLOUR-CODED YOUR DOTS SO YOU KNOW WHERE TO START AND FINISH!**



**ONCE THE SECTION IS FILLED TO YOUR LIKING, TIE YOUR YARN TIGHTLY AROUND THE FINAL NAIL TO ENSURE IT DOESN'T COME LOOSE.**

**NEXT, TRIM YOUR LOOSE PIECES OF YARN AND TUCK ANY ENDS UNDER YOUR WEAVING.**

**LAST, CAREFULLY TEAR AWAY YOUR TEMPLATE TO REVEAL YOUR FINISHED YARN ART!**



# WALL HANGING

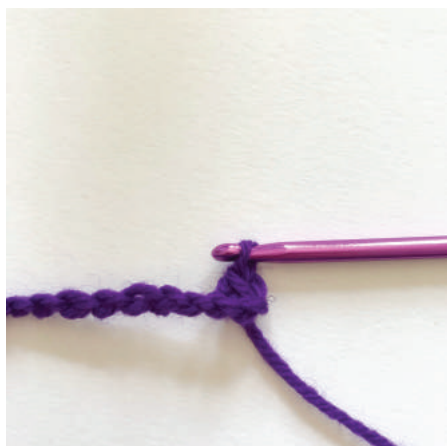
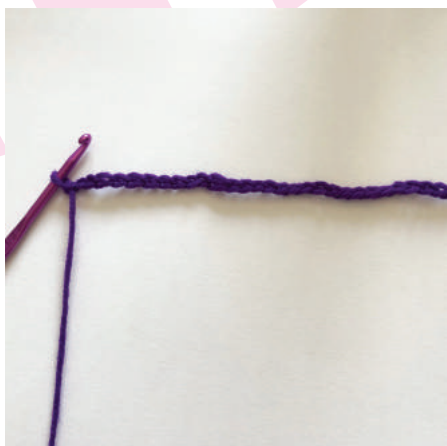




**THIS GORGEOUS WALL HANGING USES BRIGHTLY COLOURED YARN TO CREATE A QUIRKY PIECE TO LIVEN UP ANY WALL.**

**YOU WILL NEED:  
SELECTION OF 50G WOOL IN 7 BRIGHT COLOURS  
4.5MM CROCHET HOOK  
TAPESTRY NEEDLE  
SEWING SCISSORS  
30CM WOODEN DOWELLING ROD**

**ABBREVIATIONS  
SL - SLIPSTITCH  
CH - CHAIN  
DC - DOUBLE CROCHET  
TR - TREBLE CROCHET  
DTR - DOUBLE TREBLE CROCHET  
HTR - HALF TREBLE CROCHET  
ST - STITCH**



**START BY CREATING THE PEACOCK STITCH ALONG THE BOTTOM. ROW ONE - CH 30 + 1. DC 2ND CH FROM HOOK. MISS 4 CH, 9 DTR IN THE 5TH CH. MISS 4 CH, DC IN THE 5TH CH. REPEAT TWICE MORE, SO YOU HAVE 3 PEACOCK STITCHES ALONG THE ROW. CAST OFF.**



**TURN THE WORK SO YOU ARE WORKING INTO THE FIRST FOUNDATION CHAIN, CHANGE YARN COLOUR. ROW TWO - SL NEW YARN COLOUR INTO 1ST CH. CH 3 ( COUNTS AS FIRST TR). 1 TR IN EACH CHAIN ALONG TO THE END OF THE ROW. ONCE AT THE END CH 1 AND CAST OFF.**



**ROW THREE - SL NEW YARN COLOUR INTO 1ST CH. CH 1, DC INTO SAME STITCH DC IN EACH ST UNTIL THE END OF THE ROW. ONCE AT THE END CH 1 AND CAST OFF.**





**ROW FOUR – REPEAT ROW TWO. ROW FIVE – REPEAT ROWS TWO AND FOUR, CHANGING YARN COLOUR. ROW SIX – REPEAT ROW THREE CHANGING YARN COLOUR. ROW SEVEN – REPEAT ROW FIVE.**



**ROWS EIGHT TO TEN ( THREE ROWS OF TR) – CHANGE YARN COLOUR  
CH 3 ( COUNTS AS FIRST TR)  
1 TR IN EACH CHAIN ALONG TO THE END OF THE ROW  
ONCE AT THE END CH 3, AND REPEAT FOR TWO FURTHER ROWS, COMPLETING THREE IN TOTAL  
CH 1 AND CAST OFF**

**ROWS TEN TO FOURTEEN ( FOUR ROWS OF TR) – CHANGE YARN COLOUR  
CH 3 ( COUNTS AS FIRST TR)  
1 TR IN EACH CHAIN ALONG TO THE END OF THE ROW  
ONCE AT THE END CH 3, AND REPEAT FOR THREE FURTHER ROWS, COMPLETING FOUR IN TOTAL  
CH 1 AND CAST OFF**

**ROWS FOURTEEN TO NINETEEN ( FIVE ROWS OF TR) – CHANGE YARN COLOUR  
CH 3 ( COUNTS AS FIRST TR)  
1 TR IN EACH CHAIN ALONG TO THE END OF THE ROW  
ONCE AT THE END CH 3, AND REPEAT FOR FOUR FURTHER ROWS, COMPLETING FIVE IN TOTAL  
CH 1 AND CAST OFF**

**ROWS FOURTEEN TO NINETEEN ( FIVE ROWS OF TR) – CHANGE YARN COLOUR  
CH 3 ( COUNTS AS FIRST TR)  
1 TR IN EACH CHAIN ALONG TO THE END OF THE ROW  
ONCE AT THE END CH 3, AND REPEAT FOR FOUR FURTHER ROWS, COMPLETING FIVE IN TOTAL  
CH 1 AND CAST OFF**

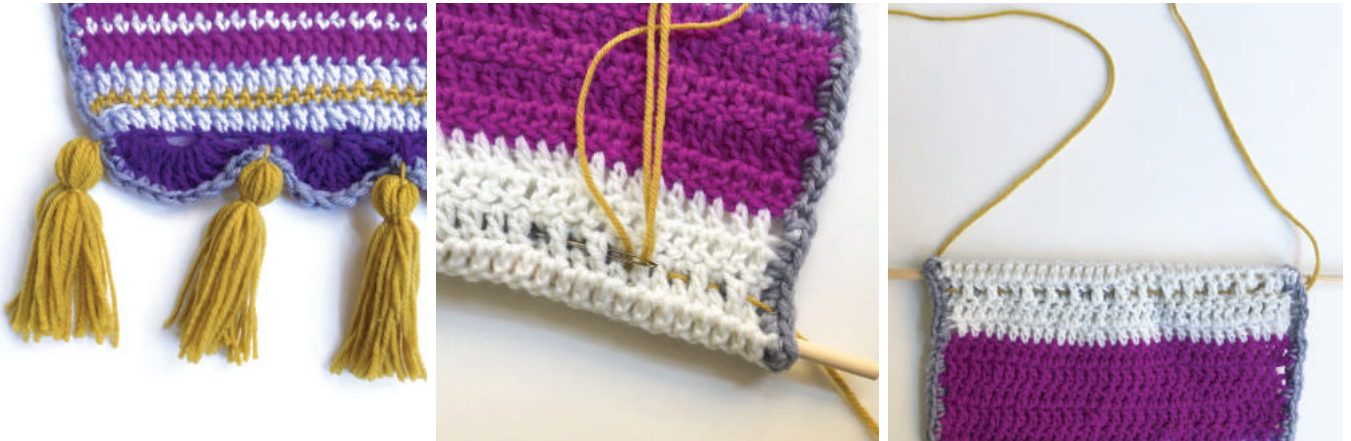
**NEATEN UP ENDS – USE THE TAPESTRY NEEDLE TO THREAD THROUGH ENDS OF YARN BACK INTO PIECE AND TRIM DOWN, THIS IS THE BEST WAY TO SECURELY DISGUISE THEM.**

**USE A FINISHING STITCH – CHANGE COLOUR AND USE A FINISHING STITCH TO NEATEN. DC ALL AROUND THE OUTSIDE OF THE WORK.**





**MAKE FOUR TASSELS - TO DO THIS SIMPLY WRAP YARN AROUND YOUR OPEN FINGERS 16 TIMES. THREAD A PIECE OF YARN ABOUT 12CM LONG THROUGH THE MIDDLE AND PULL TO THE TOP. TIE A KNOT AROUND THE OUTSIDE ABOUT 1CM FROM THE TOP. TRIM THE ENDS OPEN. REPEAT FOUR TIMES**



**TO FINISH, STITCH TASSELS TO THE BOTTOM OF THE WORK, IN BETWEEN THE PEACOCK STITCHES.**

**ATTACH THE HANGING TO THE DOWELING ROD, BY FOLDING OVER AT THE TOP AND USING A RUNNING STITCH ALONG THE WORK. KEEP 35CM LENGTHS OF YARN AT EITHER END AND TIE AN EXTRA KNOT AT EACH SIDE TO THE DOWELLING.**

**SECURE AT THE TOP WITH A BOW.**

**EVEN OUT THE WORK BY PULLING YARN TO STRAIGHTEN AND HANG!**
