POLICE INFORMATION CHECKS FOR VOLUNTEERS

As per Regina Public school board policy, anyone who volunteers at school related activity and has direct contact with students is required to have a police information check completed by the Regina Police Service for Regina residents, and local RCMP detachment for those living outside city limits, and submitted to the school office. This would include but not be limited to chaperoning music tours and retreats, uniform volunteers, etc. If you have questions about police information checks, please contact the Campbell music teachers.
