

Campbell Music Uniform expectations, care and cleaning

For ALL music students

Dress pants/Dress shirts/Grade 9 t-shirts: Please ensure that your pants are dress pants, not khakis, yoga pants or jeans. If a belt is needed it must also be black. Dress shirts must be all black with black buttons. Launder according to the label.

Black Socks/Tights: Remember that all students must wear black socks/tights for all performances. Socks need to be long enough to cover the ankle and lower calf/shin when seated – ankle socks are not sufficient. For tours it is best to pack at least 3 pairs of black socks/tights.

Black Dress Shoes: Please ensure that your shoes are entirely black, and that they are clean and in good condition. Boots or athletic shoes are not appropriate for performances. Women, please wear flat or very low shoes.

Hair: Men and women with long hair need to have enough hair ties/pins to keep your hair off of your face.

Garment Bags: For tours (or anytime you need to transport your uniform) hang your dress/shirt/pants/vest on a sturdy hanger in your Campbell Music garment bag and ensure that your name label is still in it. Grade 9 students and new Grade 10-12 students will receive a complimentary garment bag from CAMPA volunteers at an arranged time. If your garment bag needs to be replaced, please [click here to order a new one online](#), and a CAMPA volunteer will see that it is given to you at school. When packing, include your black shoes, tie, scarf, belt and other uniform accessories in the garment bag. Consider placing small items in a grocery bag hanging from the hanger and shoes in a separate plastic bag at the bottom of the garment bag.

For Grade 10, 11 & 12 Students

Vests & Ties: Please remember that the vests and ties are **NOT WASHABLE**. Keep them on a hanger to air out, or have them dry-cleaned if they are dirty. Some of the men have lost a button from their vests. Please check your vests. **Replace any missing buttons** (there may be a spare one on the inside of the vest, if not please email admin@campa.ca to request a new one) and secure the others if they are loose.

Scarves: Hand wash and hang to dry if needed.

Dresses: Machine wash on a gentle cycle and dry on a low setting. Please check the shoulder loops that hold your scarf in place. Some have torn and been repaired with safety pins. Also check your hems and make the necessary repairs so that your dress is in good shape again. Ensure that appropriate undergarments are selected so that bra straps are not visible.

More details will come from your teachers regarding packing for tours.
