## Corner Shelf Installation Curved and Pentagon

Note: Each shelf has 4 brackets -2 per side of the shelf.

1. Decide on the height you would like your shelves.
2. Hold the shelf in the position you have chosen using a spirit level to ensure it is level.
3. With a pencil mark a line along the bottom of the shelf for both sides of the shelf.
4. Using a ruler, make a mark along both lines at the appropriate distance for the shelf you are installing - see table below.

| Shelf Size | Distance from <br> corner of the wall | Distance from <br> corner of the wall |
| :--- | :--- | :--- |
| Small | 5 cm | 12 cm |
| Medium | 5 cm | 15 cm |
| Large | 5 cm | 17 cm |

5. Place a bracket at each mark, ensuring it is at a right angle to the wall with the bottom of the bracket sitting on the line. Mark the screw hole with a pencil. Repeat for each of the 4 brackets.
6. Drill the holes, hammer in the rawl plugs and screw in the brackets (NOTE: use the longer screws).
7. Place your shelf on the brackets and screw in the screws provided to secure your shelf (NOTE: use the shorter screws).
