## ring sizing guide

## Print this page on A4 paper.

(Make sure to turn off all 'shrink to fit' settings and print the document at 100% or your sizing won't be accurate)

To size a ring on your or your partner's hand:

- Cut out the ring sizer at the bottom of this page.
- Cut the small slit that is marked with an arrow.
- Place ring sizer comfortably around the finger by slipping pointed end through the slit, with the numbers facing out.
- Secure the ring sizer by pulling the pointed end snuggly around your finger like a belt (it should be tight but can still move it around to be sure it's not too tight or too loose).
- Your approximate ring size should be the number that appears where it says 'read size here'.

If the finger is not available for measuring (ie it is a surprise gift), then use a ring from the individual's current jewellery collection.

Place the correct sized ring on a circle within the chart to the right.

The correct ring size is the circle that fits right against the *inside* edge of the ring.
