As you make this useful bag, you will learn how to:

- Quilt fabric with Soft and Stable
- Make an interfaced handle
- Attach a zipper and border to a mesh pocket
- Make custom bias binding
- · Bind raw edges

These are all skills used in many of our patterns so you'll be well on your way to many other bagmaking adventures once you've mastered these techniques!

- Basic sewing kit, including #90/14 topstitch needles, Wonder Clips, a stiletto, pins (the large yellow-topped quilting pins work best), scissors, thread, chalk marker or similar tool for marking lines, etc.

To make best use of class time, please complete these steps BEFORE coming to class: Follow the cutting and quilting instructions on page 1 of the pattern (Sec A & B 1 & 2 - Cut and Quilt) to cut all the pieces for the project. Then quilt the appropriate pieces, we will do B 3 in class.
