

# Piecekeeper

## Class Description

Store and carry all your project pieces or supplies in this handy zippered bag with attached handle. Fabric quilted with Soft and Stable® makes a sturdy base and the mesh front affords great visibility of contents plus a bit of added stretchiness.

The Piecekeeper pattern is a perfect way to learn some of the basic techniques used to make ByAnnie patterns.

As you make this useful bag, you will learn how to:

- Quilt fabric with Soft and Stable
- Make an interfaced handle
- Attach a zipper and border to a mesh pocket
- Make custom bias binding
- Bind raw edges

These are all skills used in many of our patterns so you'll be well on your way to many other bagmaking adventures once you've mastered these techniques!

- 3 fat quarters
- Mesh

## ALSO BRING TO CLASS:

- Sewing machine in good working order with walking foot, 1/4" foot, and zipper foot. Don't forget the extension table for your machine.
- Rotary cutter and rulers
- Basic sewing kit, including #90/14 topstitch needles, Wonder Clips, a stiletto, pins (the large yellow-topped quilting pins work best), scissors, thread, chalk marker or similar tool for marking lines, etc.

## BEFORE CLASS:

To make best use of class time, please complete these steps BEFORE coming to class:

Follow the cutting and quilting instructions on page 1 of the pattern (Sec A & B 1 & 2 - Cut and Quilt) to cut all the pieces for the project. Then quilt the appropriate pieces, we will do B 3 in class.
